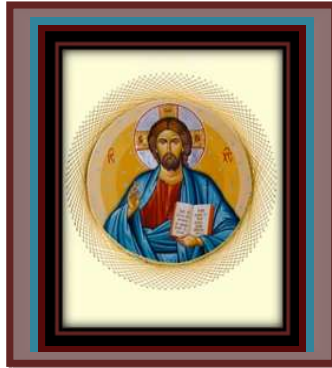

PASTORAL CARE INFORMATION

Baptism: Expectant parents are encouraged to call the Parish Office to register for a preparation program.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date.

Care of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.

Program of Religious Education.....Monday 6:15 PM at School

We provide a Roman Catholic religious education to the children grades Kindergarten through 8th. We teach the doctrine of our Catholic Church utilizing Diocesan programs. Our Catechists share their own faith commitment as well as their knowledge, always mindful of our Catholic traditions. Preparing for Holy Week

Palm Sunday - This day celebrates when Jesus triumphantly entered Jerusalem the week before his crucifixion. John 12:12-13 describes people laying palm branches down in front of Jesus as he entered Jerusalem.

Maundy Thursday, or Holy Thursday is a day when people reflect on the Passover Meal or Last Supper. This is the day when Jesus called his disciples together for one last meal in preparation of the events that would proceed in the days to come.

Good Friday is recognized as the day Jesus was crucified and died on the cross. This day is a key day in the Catholic faith. Meditating on this day and remembering the reality of Jesus dying on the cross to take away our sins is of utmost importance.

Holy Saturday - This day is the day between Jesus' death and resurrection. This is the day when Jesus descended into hell to take back the keys to death.

Easter Sunday is the best day of week. It is a day to celebrate and rejoice that our King has risen from grave and beat eternal death forever! The best way to celebrate this day is to read what God has in Word for us and rest in the fact that Jesus paid the ultimate price for each of us so we can dwell with God forever in his glory.
