Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Holy day of Obligation Mass Schedule Monday Dec. 9th at 8:45 am & 6:30 pm

The Immaculate Conception is a Catholic dogma that states the Virgin Mary was conceived without original sin:

Explanation

The Immaculate Conception is one of the four Marian dogmas of the Catholic Church. It refers to Mary's conception in the womb of her mother, St. Anne, without the stain of original sin. The Catholic Church teaches that Mary was conceived by normal biological means, but God acted upon her soul at the time of her conception.

Feast day

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is celebrated on December 8th. The Church has celebrated this feast since at least the fifth century, and it became a Holy Day of Obligation in 1708.

Transfer of the Obligation with the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

Recently the USCCB received a clarification on how the Holy Day of Obligation transfers with the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. The Holy See clarified that the Holy Day of Obligation for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception transfers with the solemnity. So when the Solemnity falls on a Sunday and is moved to Monday, the obligation is also retained on Monday. This also applies when the Solemnity naturally falls on Saturday or Monday. And so this year, the Immaculate Conception is on Monday December 9, and the obligation is retained.
