

**Baptism:** Expectant parents are encouraged to call the Parish Office to register for a preparation program.

**RCIA** (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date.

Care of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.



#### First Sunday of Advent November 28<sup>nd</sup>

The First Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the Advent season, which lasts for around 22 to 28 days before Christmas. The first Sunday of Advent is the Sunday that falls nearest to St. Andrew's Day (which



takes place on November 30). The period of Advent is when Christians and Catholics begin preparations to celebrate Christmas and the birth of Jesus Christ.

#### The First Sunday of Advent

The First Sunday of Advent is considered the most important of the four Advent Sundays because it is when the preparations for Christmas and the Advent of Jesus Christ begin. This is the day when people start looking forward to the Second Coming of Christ.

Many people also begin opening their Advent calendars on this day, counting down the days until Christmas by opening a different window on each day which has different chocolate or treat behind.

 Fun fact: the Advent calendar became popular in the United States after World War II, when soldiers returning home from Europe brought advent calendars for their children, thus beginning that tradition in America.

This is also the day when the first candle of the Advent wreath is lit. The wreath, made with fir tree, usually has four candles for the four Sundays of advent. The candlelit on the First Sunday of Advent symbolizes Hope. On the wreath, three of the candles are purple or blue, and one is pink.
