

Divine Mercy Devotion Service Sunday, April 11 3:00 PM

Jesus Himself spoke to St. Faustina Kowalska, teaching her about His great mercy towards sinners. He asked that on the Sunday following Easter a feast be solemnly celebrated. On this day, Our Lord promised that the divine floodgates through which mercy flows, would be wide open and the soul that will have gone to Confession and received Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. This is known as a Plenary Indulgence.

Divine Mercy Sunday was fixed on the Church calendar on April 30, 2000 and has been officially recognized by the Vatican. This devotion was close to the heart of St. John Paul II and has rapidly spread throughout the world. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has urged us to keep in mind that we are now living in a time of mercy.
