

Enjoy the hospitality of your good people in this parish. Once more, welcome Bishop Checcio and have a wonderful day!


Reverend Yeruva Ignatius, a Missionary preist from the Missionaries of Campassion

Feast of St. Mary Magdalene Wednesday ~ July 22nd

St. Mary Magdalene is the patron saint of contemplative life, converts, hairstylists, penitents, perfume makers, and women. She has been



designated as the patron of hairstylists and perfume makers due to the Gospel story of her anointing Jesus' feet.

St. Mary Magdalene is one of the greatest saints of the Bible and a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels.

Mary Magdalene is the first among the women following Jesus to proclaim Him as having overcome death. She is the first to announce the joyful message of Easter. But she also proved she was among those who loved Him most when she stood at the foot of the Cross on Mount Calvary together with Mary, His Mother, and the disciple, St. John. She did not deny him or run away in fear as the other disciples did, but remained close to Him every moment, up to and including the tomb.
