



Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Tuesday, November 21st

What happened at the presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary?

It commemorates a visit by the three-yearold Mary to the Temple in Jerusalem, where she was dedicated to the



service of God and left to be raised as a consecrated virgin. This act was done in fulfillment of a sacred promise made by her parents, Saints Anne and Joachim, during their long struggle with childlessness.

Mary, the first disciple ~ Mary is the woman who knows how to listen, who knows how to contemplate, who knows how to refer everything to her Son - "Do whatever He tells you" (Jn. 2:5). Mary is the One who never abandoned her Son Jesus, not even along the way of the Cross. She "stood" under the Cross. She is a disciple who never abandons the Lord Jesus, who always "stands behind" Him.

On October 3, 1789, President George Washington received a message from Congress requesting him "to recommend to the people of the United States a day of public thanksgiving and prayer."

His proclamation declared that the day "be devoted by the People of these States to the service of that great and glorious Being, who is the beneficent Author of all the good that was, that is, or that will be."

Thanksgiving has roots in recognizing the many blessings God has given us, as individuals and collectively as a country. More than 230 years later, millions of Americans continue to celebrate Thanksgiving with an eye toward God as the original source of all for which we have to be grateful.
