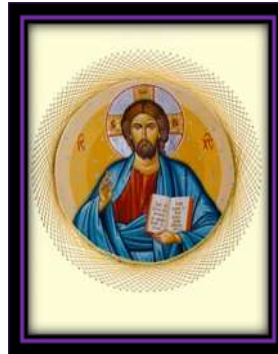

## PASTORAL CARE INFORMATION

**Baptism:** Expectant parents are encouraged to call the Parish Office to register for a preparation program.

**RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults):** The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date.

**Care of the Sick:** Please contact the Parish Office when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.

We provide a Roman Catholic religious education to the children grades Kindergarten through 8th. We teach the doctrine of our Catholic Church utilizing Diocesan programs. Our Catechists share their own faith commitment as well as their knowledge, always mindful of our Catholic traditions. 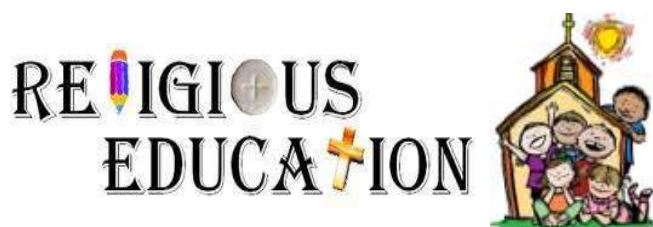

## The Most Holy Trinity ~ Trinity Sunday



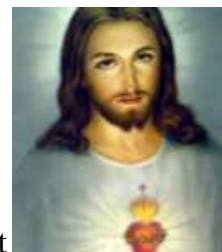
The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (paragraph 234) teaches,

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith." The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin."

The objects of the Christian Faith, such as the Trinity, are above created natures. As *supernatural* realities, they cannot be discovered by reason or the senses, but must be revealed by God, who alone fully knows and understands them. This makes the Trinity a *mystery*.

## June is dedicated to The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Catholic Church dedicates June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a tradition that dates back to the 17th century. The tradition began when French nun St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had visions of Jesus Christ revealing his Sacred Heart to her. In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and established June as the Month of the Sacred Heart in his encyclical letter *Annum sacrum*. The letter also encouraged the Roman Catholic episcopate to promote First Friday Devotions and included the Prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart.



The term "Sacred Heart of Jesus" refers to the entire mystery of Christ, including his role as the Son of God, his uncreated wisdom, his infinite charity, and his role in the salvation and sanctification of mankind.
