

## The Seasons of the Liturgical Year



#### **Advent:**

A season of waiting and preparation for the coming of Christ, lasting about four weeks before Christmas.

#### **Christmas:**

Celebrates the Nativity of Jesus Christ.

## **Ordinary Time (first part after Epiphany):**

A period following Christmas and Epiphany, focusing on the life and teachings of Christ.

#### Lent:

A solemn season of penance, prayer, and fasting in preparation for Easter, lasting about six weeks.

Holy Week and Sacred Paschal Triduum: The holiest three days of the Church's year, commemorating the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

#### **Easter:**

A joyous celebration of Jesus' resurrection,

Followed by a 50-day season culminating in Pentecost.

#### **Ordinary Time** (second part after Pentecost):

Another period of ordinary time, reflecting on Christ's continued presence and the work of the Holy Spirit.
