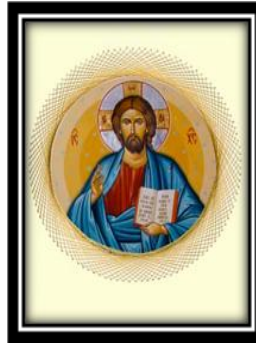

PASTORAL CARE INFORMATION

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date.

Care of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.

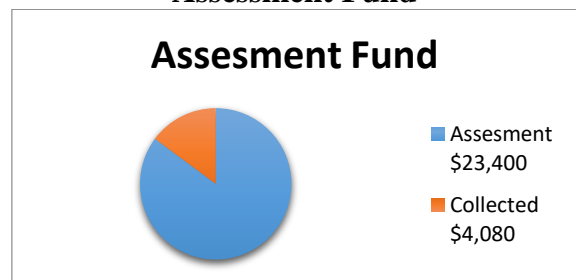

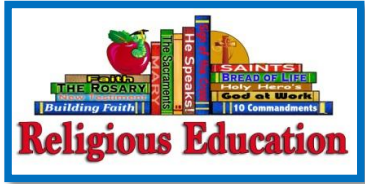

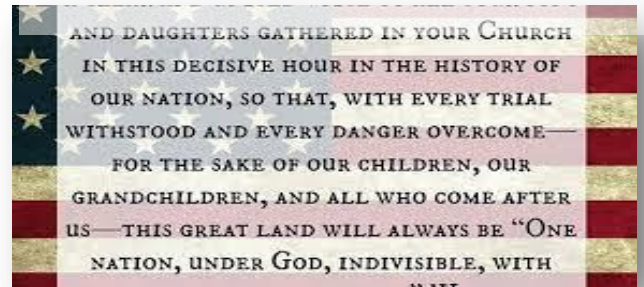

This week is the Fourth of July, Independence Day in the United States. For our children, that can mean a lot of things – fireworks, picnics, parades, flag waving. All of these are wonderful, but as Catholics, we can make the celebration much more spiritual, and profound.

What is patriotism?

Patriotism is generally understood as a virtue, as a particular expression of piety, which stems from the cardinal virtue of justice. The word “patriotism” comes from the Latin “patria,” which means “father.” Patriotism, then, is a love of one’s fatherland, and the fellow children of that land. That last point is important. Patriotism is meaningless unless it is directed primarily toward persons. For this reason, patriotism is connected to love of neighbor, and even more particularly, to love of one’s family.
