June is dedicated to The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Catholic Church dedicates June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a tradition that dates back to the 17th century. The tradition began when French nun

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had visions of Jesus Christ revealing his Sacred Heart to her. In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and established June as the Month of the Sacred Heart



in his encyclical letter Annum sacrum. The letter also encouraged the Roman Catholic episcopate to promote First Friday Devotions and included the Prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart.

The term "Sacred Heart of Jesus" refers to the entire mystery of Christ, including his role as the Son of God, his uncreated wisdom, his infinite charity, and his role in the salvation and sanctification of mankind.
