

Baptism: Expectant parents are encouraged to call the Parish Office to register for a preparation program.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): The preparation process for adults who wish to consider becoming Catholic or who wish to complete their Catholic sacramental formation. Contact the Parish Office.

Marriage: Couples planning to marry should contact the Parish Office at least one year prior to a tentative wedding date.

Care of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office when someone is sick, hospitalized or unable to attend Mass so that arrangements may be made for those who wish to receive Communion and the Anointing of the Sick.

Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Holy day of Obligation Mass Schedule

Monday Dec. 8th at 8:45 am & 6:30 pm

The Immaculate Conception is a Catholic dogma that states the Virgin Mary was conceived without original sin:

• Explanation

The Immaculate Conception is one of the four Marian dogmas of the Catholic Church. It refers to Mary's conception in the womb of her mother, St. Anne, without the stain of original sin. The Catholic Church teaches that Mary was conceived by normal biological means, but God acted upon her soul at the time of her conception.

Feast day

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is celebrated on December 8th. The Church has celebrated this feast since at least the fifth century, and it became a Holy Day of Obligation in 1708.

Transfer of the Obligation with the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

Recently the USCCB received a clarification on how the Holy Day of Obligation transfers with the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. The Holy See clarified that the Holy Day of Obligation for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception transfers with the solemnity. So when the Solemnity falls on a Sunday and is moved to Monday, the obligation is also retained on Monday. This also applies when the Solemnity naturally falls on Saturday or Monday. And so this year, the Immaculate Conception is on Monday December 8, and the obligation is retained.
