

Feast of Our Lady of Fatima ~ May 13th

May 13 is the anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady to three shepherd children in the small village of Fatima in Portugal in 1917. She appeared six times to Lucia 9, and her cousins Francisco 8, and his sister Jacinta, 6, between May 13, 1917 and October 13, 1917.



At the very first apparition at Fatima on May 13, Mary asked the three seers, "Are you willing to offer yourselves to God and bear all the sufferings He wills to send you as an act of reparation for the sins by which He is offended and in supplication for the conversion of sinners?"
