This past Friday, February 2nd, the Church celebrated the World Day for Consecrated Life. In addition to the commitments a consecrated person makes, there are also charisms that they

A charism – Pope Francis says – is not given by the Holy Spirit to be preserved like a bottle of distilled water – but to be opened and allowed to go out, to bring life, growth, renewal, and transformation. 'Let us go on to the neighboring towns, so that I may proclaim the message there also, for that is what I came out to do.' This is the logic of charisms.
