Day 1- Friday, May 12th

Welcome to England! We meet our driver and executive coach this morning at the London Heathrow Airport and travel into Surrey for a visit to **Wisley**, the flagship garden of the Royal Horticultural Society and one of the great gardens of the world! Wisley houses one of the largest plant collections with 240 acres of diverse gardens, an extensive arboretum, a spectacular glasshouse and the newly opened RHS Hilltop. This state-of-the-art science building is surrounded by three spectacular new gardens that embrace the latest ideas in horticulture, as well as a new Trials Garden. There'll be time for lunch and to look around the well-stocked garden center. Lots of inspiration to be had here!

Day 2- Saturday, May 13th

This morning we visit **Great Dixter**, the family home of the late, great gardener and garden writer Christopher Lloyd. This garden is renowned for its bold and daring color combinations and

its innovative plantings. Later, we visit **Pashley Manor Gardens**, a quintessential English garden. Pashley offers a sumptuous blend of romantic landscaping, imaginative plantings and fine old trees, fountains, springs, and large ponds. We'll enjoy a delicious, locally sourced lunch in their café, followed by a guided tour of the gardens. We continue to the charming spa town of **Royal Tunbridge Wells** for some free time to explore the rich heritage and stunning architecture.



Day 3- Sunday, May 14th

This morning we visit **Igtham Mote**, a lovely 14-acre garden surrounding a picturesque medieval moated manor house C1320. In the afternoon, visit **Hever Castle**, once the childhood home of Anne Boleyn, second wife of Henry V111 and mother of Elizabeth I. These award-winning gardens feature the magnificent Italian Garden with its classical statuary, many water features and cool, shady grottos.

Day 4- Monday, May 15th

Today we depart for Salisbury but first, we visit Sissinghurst Castle Garden. Writers Vita



Sackville-West and Harold Nicolson fell in love with Sissinghurst and created this world-renowned historic garden in the 20th c. We travel on from Kent into Surrey passing through the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty before arriving at **Ramster Garden**. This beautiful woodland garden is famous for its stunning spring color, with over 25 acres of peaceful woodland, views of lakes and hillsides, filled with color and interest.

Day 5- Tuesday, May 16th

The medieval city of **Salisbury** is known for its stunning cathedral, captivating history, and ageless beauty. We spend our day here with a guiding walking tour, a visit to the cathedral and some free time to explore on our own.

Day 6- Wednesday, May 17th

Today we visit **Stonehenge**— one of the wonders of the world and the best-known prehistoric monument in Europe. We continue to the Georgian City of **Bath** for lunch and some time to enjoy

this elegant city. Later this afternoon, we tour **Iford Manor Gardens**, a 2.5-acre terraced garden filled with inspiration! Steep flights of steps link the terraces with pools, fountains, urns, colonnades, and statues. (Note –this garden is on a steeply terraced hillside, access can be difficult for some). We'll enjoy a private guided tour of the main garden and an exclusive visit of the family's own 1.5-acre private gardens not usually open to the public.

Day 7- Thursday, May 18th

We spend our day in 2 delightful gardens with lunch in a pretty village pub. **Kiftsgate Court Garden** is perched on the edge of the Cotswolds with wonderful views and was created by 3 generations of women. The garden features rare plants and shrubs including the world famous *Kiftsgate rose*. The wonderful **Hidcote Garden** is an Arts and Craftsinspired Garden with intricately designed outdoor spaces to explore in the Cotswold hills. This fabulous garden was created by talented American horticulturist Major Lawrence Johnston and is characterized by its colorful outdoor 'rooms' that are full of surprises.

Day 8- Friday, May 19th

Today we travel through picturesque villages and visit a private garden with free time in the beautiful and historic village of **Burford**. In the afternoon, we explore **Bourton House Garden**, an award-winning 3-acre garden surrounding an 18th century Manor House and 16th century Tithe Barn. Bourton House Garden features terraces and wide herbaceous borders with stunning plants, texture, and colorful combinations, a topiary walk, a White Garden and several spring-fed water features including a raised basket pond from the Great Exhibition of 1851. A raised 18th century walk provides an enticing visual link to the Cotswold landscape beyond.

Day 9- Saturday, May 20th

Today we visit **Blenheim Palace**, a World Heritage Site with over 300 years of history and home

to the 12th Duke of Marlborough and his family. Created over the centuries by esteemed garden designers such as Henry Wise and Achille Duchêne, the beautiful Formal Gardens reflect a journey through the styles of the ages. The Formal Gardens surround the Palace, and they include the majestic Water Terraces, the Duke's Private Italian Garden, the tranquil Secret Garden with all its hidden treasures, the Churchill Memorial Garden, and the beautifully delicate Rose Garden.



This afternoon, we explore **Rousham House and Gardens**. Rousham is completely unspoilt and uncommercialized – no tea room and no shop – just glorious gardens to explore. One of England's most important gardens, Rousham represents the first phase of English landscape design and remains almost as its designer William Kent left it. Many of the features that delighted its 18th century visitors are still there for 21st century visitors to enjoy. A favorite of many great garden designers, in his 'Around the World in Eighty gardens" Monty Don says, "Kent is the great genius of eighteenth-century garden design and Rousham is his masterpiece, one of the greatest gardens in the world".

Richmond Hill Hotel- 4 nights

Day 10- Sunday, May 21st

This morning we enjoy a panoramic **sightseeing tour of London** with our London Guide, passing famous sights such as Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, Houses of Parliament and



Big Ben, St Paul's Cathedral and The Tower of London. In the afternoon, we explore **Hampton Court Palace** and enjoy a guided tour of the Palace and Gardens. Experience the public dramas and private lives of Henry VIII, his wives, and children in the world of the Tudor court. Admire the Great Hall and Tudor Kitchens. Hampton Court Palace's world-famous gardens include 60 acres of spectacular formal gardens and 750 acres of parkland, all set within a loop of the river Thames.

Day 11- Monday, May 22nd

Today we visit the Royal Botanic Gardens at Kew. Housing the world's most diverse collection of living plants, **Kew Gardens** is London's largest UNESCO World Heritage Site and is also a

world-leading scientific research center. Wander through beautiful glasshouses such as the iconic Palm House, home to an exotic rainforest; explore different climate zones at the Princess of Wales Conservatory or be amazed by the giant lily pads at the Waterlily House. For a bird's-eye view of the gardens, walk along the 59ft Treetop Walkway. Enjoy floral displays from more than 60,000 plants along the Great Broad Walk Borders or take in some of the 14,000 trees in



the colorful Arboretum. Later, we visit **Chelsea Physic Garden**, London's oldest botanic garden, containing a unique collection of around 5,000 different edible, useful and medicinal plants that have changed the world. This garden was established in 1673 by the Worshipful Society of Apothecaries of London.

Day 12- Tuesday, May 23rd

Today enjoy a full day at **RHS Chelsea Flower Show!** It's Member's Day – open only to members of the Royal Horticultural Society. Chelsea is the world's most prestigious flower show and inspires millions of gardeners each year. Its innovative garden designs give enthusiastic gardeners plenty of ideas to take home.

Day 13- Wednesday May 24th

After breakfast and check out, we transfer to London Heathrow for our return trip home.
