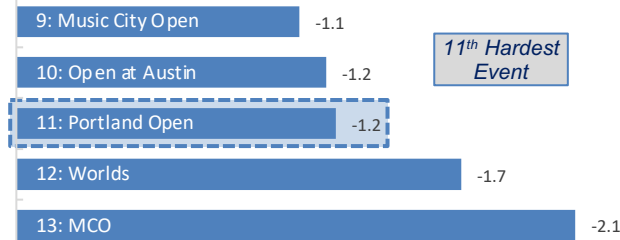

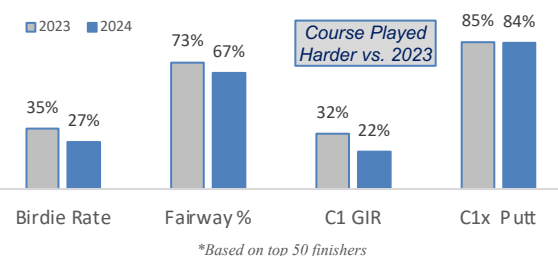

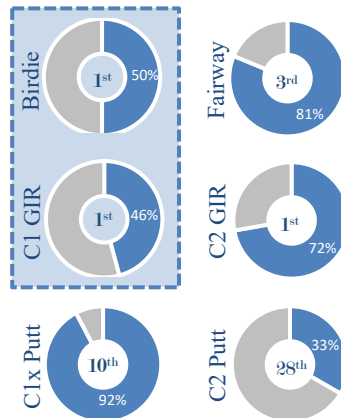
Gannon secures his second win of 2024, easily beating the field by 8 strokes...

Winner: Gannon Buhr



- Birdie rate of 50% was 10% higher than second ranked birdie rate (Cole/Ezra/Ricky), largest margin since Paul McBeth in 2019 at MVP open (11% over Simon Lizotte)...
- This gives Gannon 6 Elite/Major wins since 2022, tying Ricky Wysocki and just 1 behind Simon/Calvin...

Cole Redalen

- Was in 48th place going into Round 2 after shooting a -1 in Round 1
