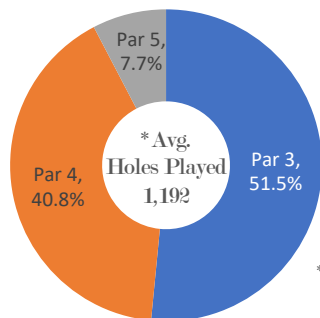




Statistics Breakdown by Par 3's vs. Par 4's vs. Par 5's

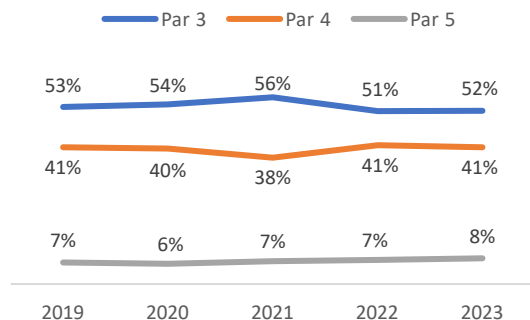
In 2023 over half of the holes played on the Pro Tour were Par 3's while only 7.7% were Par 5's. This dynamic has been consistent since 2019 with only a slight increase in Par 5's. Birdie Rates and CI GIR are highest for Par 5's, as expected.

2023 Hole Breakdown

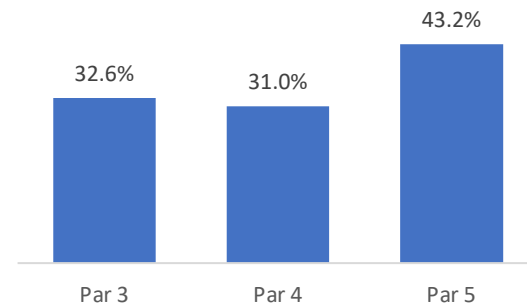

There were 6 players who placed in the top 10 in Par 3's, 4's, and 5's: **Calvin, Eagle, Ricky, Gannon, Cole, and Barela.** **Isaac** is top 7 in 3's and 4's, but drops to 27th in Par 5's. **Anttila** is top 20 in 3's and 4's, but drops to 75th in Par 5's.

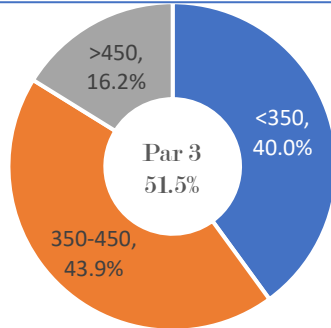

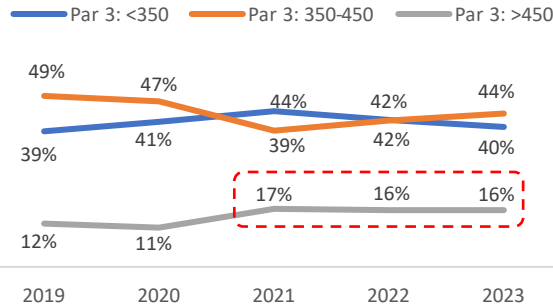
Breakdown of Par 3's by Distance

Par 3's on Tour are getting longer, with a 30% increase in holes greater than 450 feet vs. 2019. Birdie Rates and C1 GIR are significantly harder as the holes get longer.

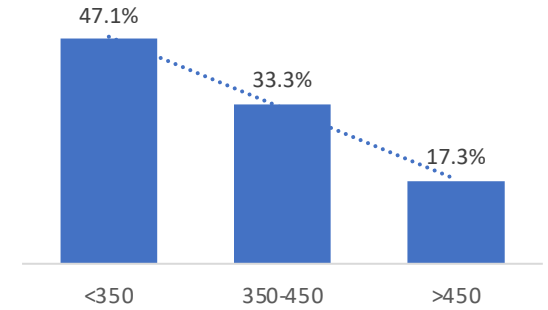
2023 Par 3's By Distance



2023 - 2019 Tour Holes



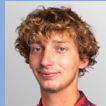
