

Goodhue 11U Baseball Tournament Rules

- This tournament is open to anyone completing the 5th grade
- Games will be as follows: 5 innings, with a 75 minute time limit on each game. No inning should start after 75 minutes.
- 7 runs per half inning unit
- Each team will supply 1 game ball per game. The game ball should be of sufficient quality (Wilson, Rawlings, Diamond...). No practice balls please.
- No leading off
- Runners may steal 2nd or 3rd after the ball is released from the pitchers hand. The first violation for leaving early will be a team warning. The second will result in the runner being called out.
- Runners may advance home only if a play is made at 3rd base or they are walked in.
- Dropped 3rd strike is an out
- A pitcher can pitch a maximum of 3 innings per game and a total of 6 per tournament (1 pitch constitutes an inning).
- No balks will be called but the umpire will make the pitcher aware if it happens
- 10 defensive players in the field (4 outfielders), unless both coaches agree on 9 fielders.
- You must bat at least 12 uniformed players if you have over 12 players, but all players can bat if coach chooses. Free substitutions.
- During the pitcher warm-ups (at any time) the catcher must wear a mask
- Pitching mound should be 46 feet (discretion of the home field coach)
- Mercy rule is in effect if team is ahead by 15 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings
- Courtesy runner is allowed for the current catcher at any time. The courtesy runner will be the last player in your lineup who made an out
- No metal spikes
- Runners must slide on all close plays
- Runner may not advance home on passed balls.

- Catcher interference will be called and the batter will take their base.
- USA Bats: Maximum diameter at the thickest part: 2 ¼” or less with unlimited weight differential and the new USA Baseball stamp on the taper. Maximum diameter at the thickest part: 2 5/8” or less with -11 weight differential and the new USA Baseball stamp on the taper. Wood bats are allowed
- If needed for medal placing, tournament will be :
 - 1 Head to head
 - 2 Runs scored
 - 3 Runs against
- Please no outside coolers brought in. This is our fundraiser for the baseball-softball association
- No field warm-ups, have your team ready to go
- Please stay off football field

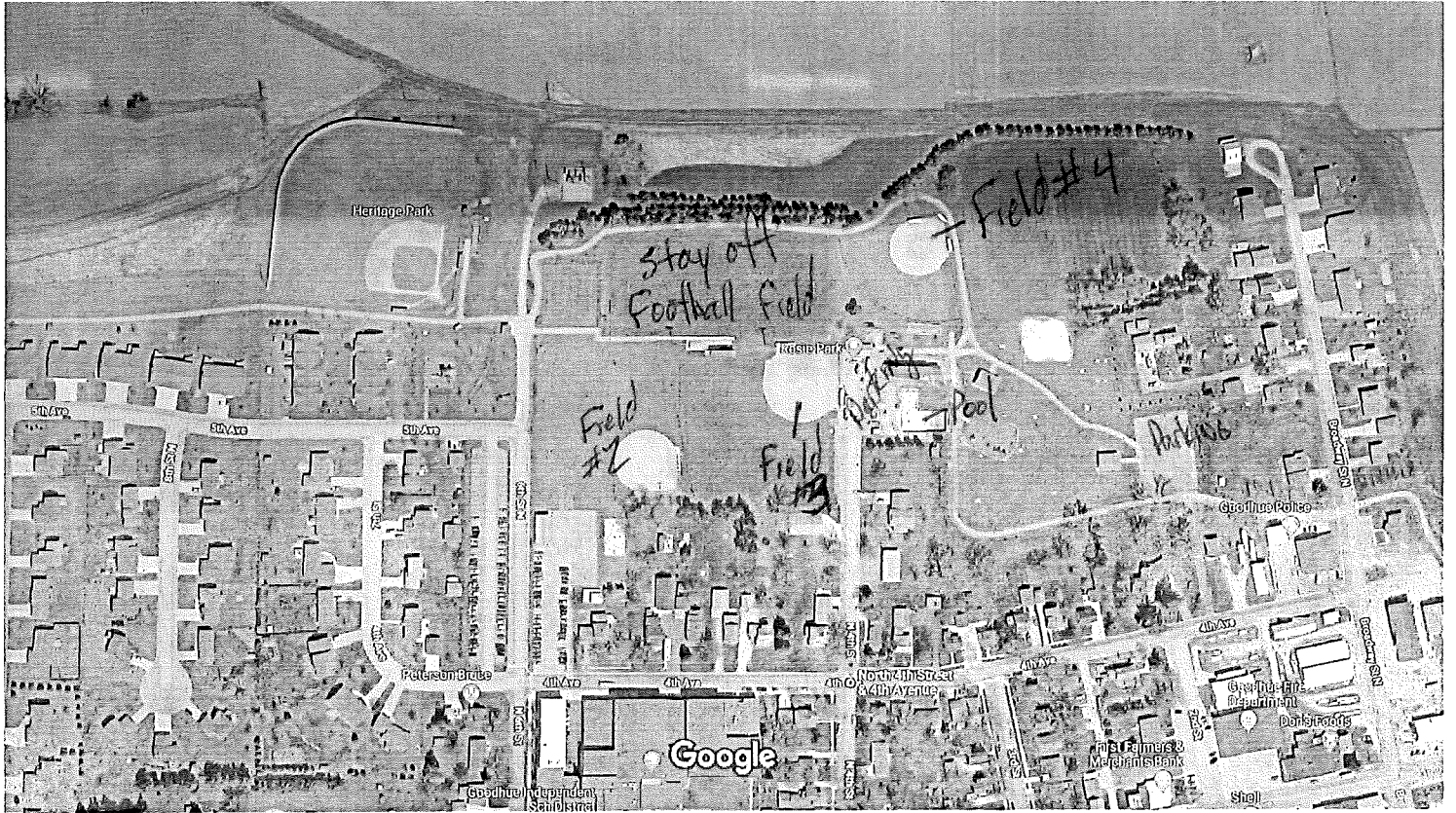
