



THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER

From a Sermon by Saint Gregory of Nazianzus, bishop

The baptism of Christ

Christ is bathed in light; let us also be bathed in light. Christ is baptized; let us also go down with him, and rise with him.

John is baptizing when Jesus draws near. Perhaps he comes to sanctify his baptizer; certainly he comes to bury sinful humanity in the waters. He comes to sanctify the Jordan for our sake and in readiness for us; he who is spirit and flesh comes to begin a new creation through the Spirit and water.

The Baptist protests; Jesus insists. Then John says: *I ought to be baptized by you.* He is the lamp in the presence of the sun, the voice in the presence of the Word, the friend in the presence of the Bridegroom, the greatest of all born of woman in the presence of the firstborn of all creation, the one who leapt in his mother's womb in the presence of him who was adored in the womb, the forerunner and future forerunner in the presence of him who has already come and is to come again. *I ought to be baptized by you:* we should also add, "and for you," for John is to be baptized in blood, washed clean like Peter, not only by the washing of his feet.

Jesus rises from the waters; the world rises with him. The heavens like Paradise with its flaming sword, closed by Adam for himself and his descendants, are rent open. The Spirit comes to him as to an equal, bearing witness to his Godhead. A voice bears witness to him from heaven, his place of origin. The Spirit descends in bodily form like the dove that so long ago announced the ending of the flood and so gives honor to the body that is one with God.

Today let us do honor to Christ's baptism and celebrate this feast in holiness. Be cleansed entirely and continue to be cleansed. Nothing gives such pleasure to God as the conversion and salvation of men, for whom his every word and every revelation exist. He wants you to become a living force for all mankind, lights shining in the world. You are to be radiant lights as you stand beside Christ, the great light, bathed in the glory of him who is the light of heaven. You are to enjoy more and more the pure and dazzling light of the Trinity, as now you have received—though not in its fullness—a ray of its splendor, proceeding from the one God, in Christ Jesus our Lord, to whom be glory and power for ever and ever. Amen.

PENSAMIENTOS PARA CONSIDERAR

De los sermones de san Gregorio Nacianceno, obispo

EL BAUTISMO DE CRISTO

Cristo es iluminado: dejémonos iluminar junto con él; Cristo se hace bautizar: descendamos al mismo tiempo que él, para ascender con él.

Juan está bautizando, y Cristo se acerca; tal vez para santificar al mismo por quien va a ser bautizado; y sin duda para sepultar en las aguas a todo el viejo Adán, santificando el Jordán antes de nosotros y por nuestra causa; y así, el Señor, que era espíritu y carne, nos consagra mediante el Espíritu y el agua.

Juan se niega, Jesús insiste. Entonces: Soy yo el que necesito que tú me bautices, le dice la lámpara al Sol, la voz a la Palabra, el amigo al Esposo, el mayor entre los nacidos de mujer al Primogénito de toda la creación, el que había saltado de júbilo en el seno materno al que había sido ya adorado cuando estaba en él, el que era y habría de ser precursor al que se había manifestado y se manifestará. Soy yo el que necesito que tú me bautices; y podría haber añadido: «Por tu causa.» Pues sabía muy bien que habría de ser bautizado con el martirio; o que, como a Pedro, no sólo le lavarían los pies.

Pero Jesús, por su parte, asciende también de las aguas; pues se lleva consigo hacia lo alto al mundo, y mira cómo se abren de par en par los cielos que Adán había hecho que se cerraran para sí y para su posteridad, del mismo modo que se había cerrado el paraíso con la espada de fuego.

También el Espíritu da testimonio de la divinidad, acudiendo en favor de quien es su semejante; y la voz desciende del cielo, pues del cielo procede precisamente Aquel de quien se daba testimonio; del mismo modo que la paloma, aparecida en forma visible, honra el cuerpo de Cristo, que por deificación era también Dios. Así también, muchos siglos antes, la paloma había anunciado el fin del diluvio.

Honremos hoy nosotros, por nuestra parte, el bautismo de Cristo, y celebremos con toda honestidad su fiesta.

Ojalá que estéis ya purificados, y os purifiquéis de nuevo. Nada hay que agrade tanto a Dios como el arrepentimiento y la salvación del hombre, en cuyo beneficio se han pronunciado todas las palabras y revelado todos los misterios; para que, como astros en el firmamento, os convirtáis en una fuerza vivificadora para el resto de los hombres; y los esplendores de aquella luz que brilla en el cielo os hagan resplandecer, como lumbres perfectas; junto a su inmensa luz, iluminados con más pureza y claridad por la Trinidad, cuyo único rayo, brotado de la única Deidad, habéis recibido inicialmente en Cristo Jesús, Señor nuestro, a quien le sean dados la gloria y el poder por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.



ANNOUNCEMENT: REDUCTION IN ASF OFFICES AND/OR POSITIONS

My Dear People of God,

We always knew that entering Chapter 11 bankruptcy was not going to be easy: however, for the healing of the victims of clergy sexual abuse and for the healing of our Church we knew it was the right decision to make. Of course, we could never have anticipated a world-wide pandemic that would make our path forward even more difficult. I write today to inform you just how difficult that path has become. Beginning on Friday, December 4th, the Catholic Center will initiate a 20% reduction of offices and/or positions, resulting in an inevitable reduction of staff. It is with a heavy heart that we say “good-bye to our trusted and appreciated colleagues at the Catholic Center.

It is impossible to put into words just how much we are going to miss our friends with whom we have ministered for so long. Some of those leaving have been with us for well over thirty years. Their dedication, competence and love for the Church stand as a fitting tribute to their legacy. We wish them well in the future and assure them of our never-ending gratitude and promise of prayer. I invite all in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe join me in this expression of gratitude and of prayerful support.

Attached to this letter you will find a summary of those offices and/or positions that have been eliminated and, in some cases, which office will be assuming new responsibilities so that we might continue to serve our parishes, schools and Catholic communities to the best of our ability. Through our Presbyteral Council, Archdiocesan Pastoral Council, Curia, Finance Council and other advisors, I will continue to assess the needs of this local Church and marshal the resources at our disposal to serve the faithful of this wonderful archdiocese. Together we will get through this difficult period in our history and with God’s grace continue to celebrate Christ’s presence in our midst.

In order to plan for our future as the Body of Christ even as we continue to heal the past, I am in the process of commissioning a working group that will reflect the rich diversity of our archdiocese. This task force, together with the councils mentioned above, will reflect all the People of God as they assist me in forging a path forward for our local Church. In the spirit of our archdiocesan patron, I am asking this new working group to respond to Christ’s call made so many centuries ago to St. Francis from the San Damiano cross: ‘Rebuild My Church.’ Jour-

neying together, with Christ among us and with the assistance of the prayers of Our Lady of Guadalupe, we will move forward with hope and determination as we begin a new chapter in our lives of faith here in the Southwest.

For over 400 years, the Catholic Church has been a beacon of hope and a source of life for countless souls in this portion of the Lord’s vineyard. Standing on the shoulders of our ancestors in the faith, we will continue to be, in the words of *Lumen Gentium* (A Light to the Nations), a light of Christ shining brightly in our midst, a light that the darkness cannot extinguish (John 1:5). Please pray for this intention and for our friends who are leaving the Catholic Center but remaining always in our hearts.

CARTA DEL ARZOBISPO JOHN C. WESTER SOBRE CAMBIOS EN LA ARQUIDIÓCESIS DE SANTA FE

23 de noviembre de 2020

Mi querido pueblo de Dios:

Siempre supimos que declarar la bancarrota bajo el Capítulo 11 no iba a ser fácil; sin embargo, para poder ayudar a la sanación de las víctimas de abuso sexual por parte del clero y para la sanación de nuestra Iglesia, sabíamos que esa era la decisión más apropiada que debíamos tomar. Por supuesto, nunca podríamos haber anticipado una pandemia mundial que haría nuestro camino aún más difícil. Escribo hoy para informarles lo difícil que se ha vuelto ese camino. A partir del viernes 4 de diciembre, el Centro Católico iniciará una reducción del 20% de las oficinas y/o puestos, lo que resultará en una inevitable reducción de personal. Es con un gran pesar que decimos "adiós" a confiables y apreciados colegas del Centro Católico.

Es imposible expresar lo mucho que vamos a extrañar a los amigos con los que hemos trabajado durante tanto tiempo. Algunos de los que se van han estado con nosotros durante más de treinta años. Su dedicación, capacidad y amor por la Iglesia es un tributo adecuado a su legado. Les deseamos lo mejor en el futuro y les aseguramos nuestra interminable gratitud y promesa de oración. Invito a todos en la Arquidiócesis de Santa Fe a unirse a mí en esta expresión de gratitud y apoyo en oración.

Adjunto a esta carta encontrarán un resumen de los cargos y/o posiciones que han sido eliminados y, en algunos casos, cuál oficina asumirá nuevas responsabilidades para que podamos continuar sirviendo a nuestras parroquias, escuelas y comunidades católicas de la mejor manera posible. A través del Consejo Presbiteral, Consejo Pastoral Arquidiocesano, Curia, Consejo de Finanzas y otros asesores, continuaré evaluando las necesidades de esta Iglesia local y reuniendo los recursos con los que contamos para servir a los fieles de esta maravillosa arquidiócesis. Juntos superaremos este difícil período de nuestra historia y con la gracia de Dios continuaremos celebrando la presencia de Cristo en medio de nosotros.

Con la finalidad de planificar nuestro futuro como el Cuerpo de Cristo, incluso mientras continuamos sanando el pasado, estoy en el proceso de comisionar un grupo de trabajo que reflejará la rica diversidad de nuestra arquidiócesis. Este grupo de trabajo, junto con los consejos mencionados anteriormente, reflejará a todo el Pueblo de Dios mientras me ayudan a forjar un camino hacia adelante para nuestra Iglesia local. En el espíritu de nuestro patrón arquidiocesano, le pido a este nuevo grupo de trabajo que responda al llamado de Cristo hecho hace tantos siglos a San Francisco desde

la cruz de San Damián: "Repara mi Iglesia". Caminando juntos, con Cristo entre nosotros y con la ayuda de las oraciones de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, avanzaremos con esperanza y determinación mientras comenzamos un nuevo capítulo en nuestras vidas de fe aquí en el Suroeste.




