

CHEETAH MATH SUPERSTARS

☆ A PTA Sponsored Program ☆

CHEETAH MATH is a **VOLUNTARY** supplemental math program for K-4th graders that provides fun, yet challenging, math problems to help encourage thinking skills and reinforce classroom math lessons.

PRIZES (see below) are primarily score-based. Students can earn up to 40 points per month. Receiving the highest score on each of the 12 sheets will earn the student 240 points. With two bonus sheets (December and March), those students can reach a maximum of 250 points.



Students who turn in 9 completed worksheets will earn POPSCILES with the PRINCIPAL. Students earning at least 190 points will receive **one** of three **CHEETAH MATH** trophies at their end-of-the-year Awards Program. Students who earn 245+ points will be recognized as “**Highest Score**” when receiving their trophies.

STUDENTS



- **Worksheets will be provided at the beginning of each month** (September-March). They may also be found online on the Park Glen PTA website (parkglenpta.org/cheetah-math), and there will be limited copies at the **CHEETAH MATH** table (outside of the gym).
- Carefully read through each question (with parents' help as needed) and **solve them independently**. Parents/guardians are encouraged to review worksheets for corrections and allow students to rework those solved incorrectly.




UPON COMPLETION OF THE WORKSHEET

- The worksheet is to be placed into a special, grade-specific box on the **CHEETAH MATH** table.
- Sheets may be turned in anytime during the month they're due, but no later than 3p on the due date listed. With students having an entire month to work on worksheets, no late worksheets will be

FAMILIES

- Worksheets are to be completed **at home**. Again, students are to work on the problems **independently** with only help reading the questions as needed.
- Graded worksheets will be returned the first week of the following month.
- **If your student scored less than 14 pts on a worksheet** (with the exception of month March), have him/her rework the questions missed and return to the **CHEETAH MATH** box by the date listed on the "Great Effort" note. Students can have their previous score adjusted (max 14 pts) which keeps them on track to receive 160 pts and the Treat Card coupon.
- Students will be able to track their progress on their Trophy Tracker Locker Tag (when received) throughout the program, but their "final score and prize" will also be included on their final worksheet.



Participation in **CHEETAH MATH** does not require permanent commitment. Students can stop and restart the program at any time. Although educational, this program is meant to be **FUN** above all!
