## Halloween Bat Craft

#### Supplies Needed:

- Black Construction Paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Reinforcement Labels
- White Crayon
- Clothes Pin(s)
- Bat Template (Optional)

#### Instructions:

\*If working with children, please use child safe scissors, and non-toxic glue.

1. With a white crayon, draw or trace (from template) a bat onto a piece of black construction paper.
2. Cut it out with scissors.
3. For the eyes, use a very small piece of green paper (or white paper that can be colored green). Center it on the sticky side of a reinforcement label and stick it to the face of the bat. Repeat for the 2nd eye.
4. With a white crayon, draw the mouth "with fangs".
5. Turn the bat over, and glue a small strip of cardboard to the back top of the head for extra support.
6. Put some glue on one side of the clothes pin, and stick it to the back of the bat head.
7. Let it dry.

Lastly, have fun with what you've made! Clip them to baskets, wreaths, curtains etc....

Also, be creative! if you want to "Bling" them out, go for it!
