This quilt is the second in a series using the Wyoming Valley block and is the only block used in designing the quilt. Different looks are obtained by changing the fabric placement from block to block. The block, Wyoming Valley, is from the 1930's Chicago Tribune column, Nancy Cabot, written by Loretta Leitner Rising. The Nancy Cabot column was published from 1932-1939.

This example has four commercial theme fabrics depicting four sports which include basketball, bowling, billiards, and golf. The other commercial fabrics used remain the same from block to block to give the piece continuity. All quilting is done by hand and the binding is applied by hand as well. A hanging sleeve is incorporated into the piece so that the owner can display it in his memorabilia room.
