

Wyoming Valley #3: International Harvester (93" x 81"/ 236 x 206cm)

This textile artwork was designed for a local crop farmer. It is the third quilt in the Wyoming Valley Series. He wanted a quilt to display in his new log home in the Great Room. The design used to make this art quilt is the same block used in the *Choir of Angels Tapestry* quilt as well as the example shown for the *Custom Wyoming Valley* quilt. This quilt features a navy-blue fabric that has a design like rumpled satin. The blue and the red were specifically selected by the client for the International Harvester logo, used with permission. The yellow is individual, densely packed corn kernels to represent the owner's livelihood. The fabric that looks like buttons is densely printed baseballs with dates from the 1950s. This piece is heavily hand stitched.
