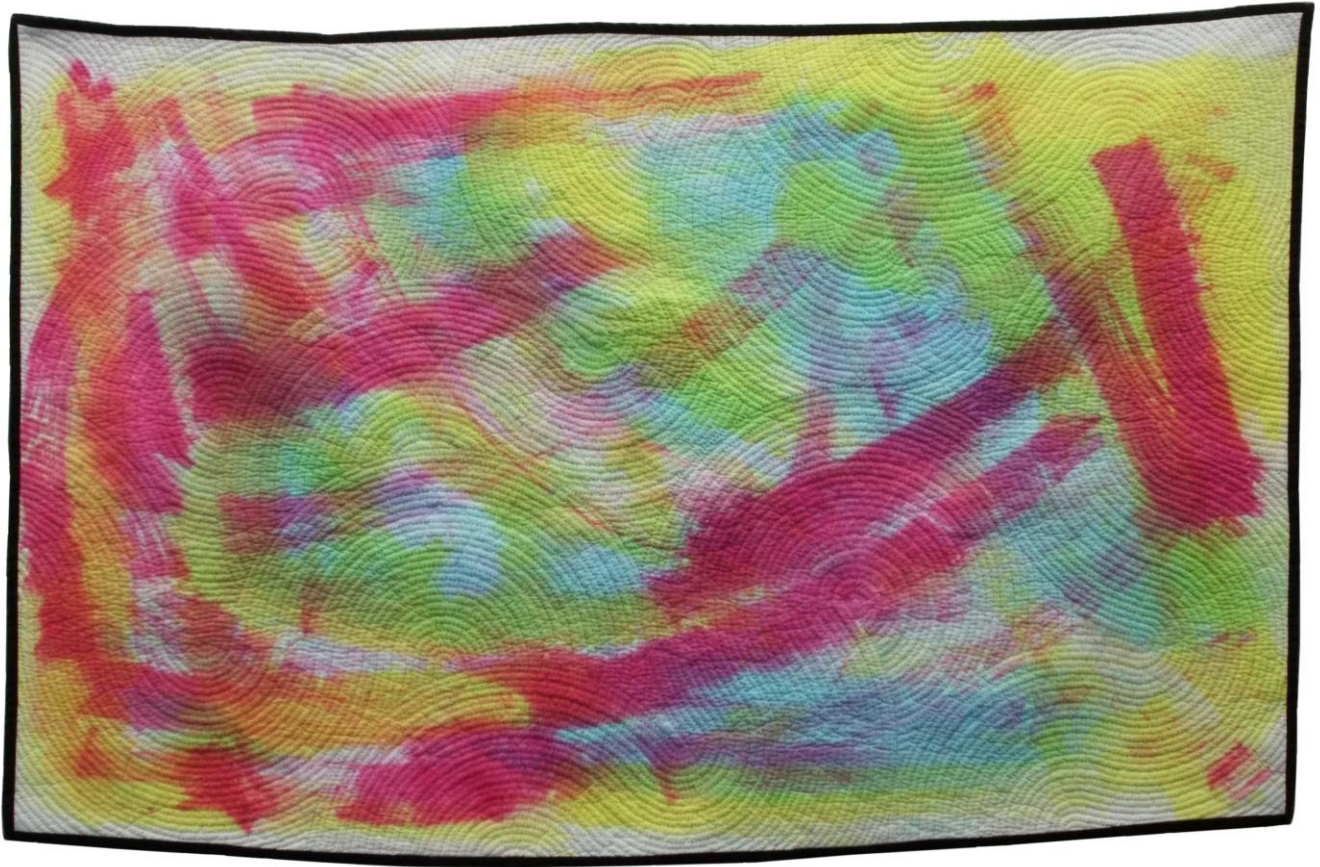

In 2011 a new direction began with this series, Abstract Textures, when I began to paint with dye using foam brushes. These abstract, whole cloth pieces are densely hand stitched to add visual as well as physical texture using a swirled or wave-like design.

Each artwork is designed to be hung in either a vertical or horizontal orientation which gives it great versatility in display options as well as changing the dynamic of the piece each time it is rotated. The back of the artwork shows the incorporated hanging system that just needs the accompanying wood slat inserted and it is ready to hang.

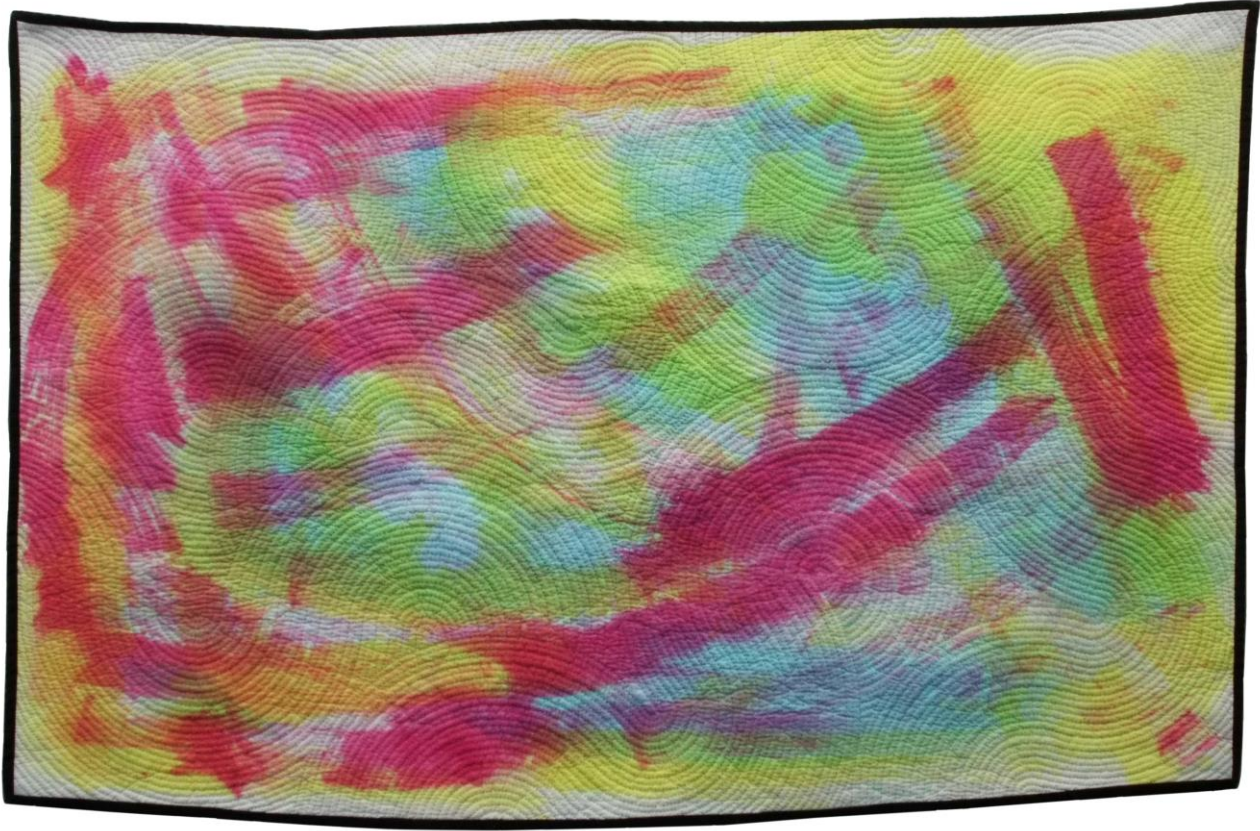


View of back of artwork

--The **Annmarie Sculpture Garden and Arts Center** has selected textile artist Jean M. Judd of Cushing, Wisconsin for inclusion in the **Folksy: cultural tradition & outside visions** Exhibition in the **Kay Daugherty Gallery**. Artwork selected for inclusion in the exhibit included: *Abstract Textures 1.1* and *Rusted Vines and Hinges*.

This exhibit explored the wide realm of folk art, outsider art, and visionary art – and other artistic expressions that are often situated outside the world of mainstream fine arts. All media accepted from small to large-scale and indoor to outdoor work including installations. Exhibition juror Elaine Eff, Folklorist, selected 95 artworks from the submission pool.
