- Completed scholarship application
- A recent copy of your school transcript showing your Grade Point Average
- Proof of acceptance or enrollment in an accredited higher educational institution
- Two letters of recommendation:
  - A recent instructor or professor who can attest to your potential for higher learning.
  - A community leader who can discuss your involvement in community service.
- Submit one essay topic: (The essay must be 500 words, typed, double-spaced, 12 pt)
  - What field of study do you plan on pursuing? What are the key factors that influenced your decision?
  - If you had the power to change or improve any aspect of the world we live in, what would you choose and why?
