**There is an ancient text** filled with awesome words of prophecy, poetry, promises, prayers, praise and parables.

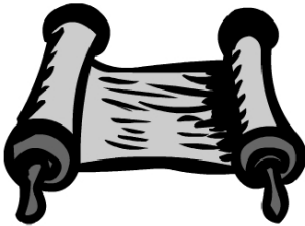
Many centuries *before* we imagined that the earth was flat, this document wrote about "**the circle of the earth.**"

- Entered Jerusalem as a king on a donkey (Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 21:4-9)
- First presented Himself as King 173,880 days from the decree to rebuild Jerusalem (Daniel 9:25; Matthew 21:4-11)
- Died a humiliating death (Psalm 22; Isaiah 53) involving: rejection (Isaiah 53:3; John 1:10-11; 7:5,48) and his hands and feet pierced (Psalm 22:16; Matthew 27:31).
- Rose from the dead! (Psalm 16:10; Mark 16:6; Acts 2:31)
- Ascended into heaven (Psalm 68:18; Acts 1:9)
