August 19th, 2024 Minutes

Vice President Pamela Beard called our meeting to order. There were no visitors.

Christy Calhoun made a motion to accept the minutes as published in the newsletter. Ellie Mills seconded the motion.

Treasurer Karen Petrignani reported we have a balance of \$2,619.48 in our account.

MQA is November 1st & 2nd in Batesville. Hotel information is on the MQA website.

Cindy Panier reported she shipped 9 pounds of cards to St Jude's. They want the front of greeting cards without any writing on them.

Sarah Ketchum is accepting donations for unused greeting cards with envelopes.

Polly has 4 or 5 shades of blue squares left over from the community quilt.

Program: Crayon Quilts by Pamela Beard. Pamela showed us the Disney Princesses quilt she made her daughter about 20 years ago. She traced the designs from coloring books with a .05 Micron Pigma Pen in assorted colors, then used Crayola Crayons to color the designs. Over the years she has touched up the coloring maybe 3 times.

She showed us flower signed she printed from EQ8. Once she colors them in, she will put the fabric between 2 sheets of newsprint and *press* with a hot iron. Do not use washable or generic crayons.

Pieces of muslin, boxes of crayons and a pigma ink pen were given to everyone to do their own crayon block.

Show-n-tell: Polly Duggan, Cindy Panier, Pam Avara, Karen Petrignani, Christy Calhoun and Pam Beard showed us their most recent finishes.

We were reminded that Rankin County Sit in Sew is September 7th and National Jelly Roll Day is September 16th.

Doris Matthews won the door prize, a copy of Quilt Folk.


The meeting was adjourned.


