### **COVID 19 Back to School Final Learning Progress Report**

Ann Arbor Learning Community (AALC) created goals for students' performance on the completion of examinations provided by the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA). The goals are as follows:

*Goal 1:* All students (K-8) will improve performance in Reading/ELA from Fall to Spring as measured by NWEA.

*Goal 2:* All students (K-8) will improve performance in Mathematics from Fall to Spring as measured by NWEA.

The following summarizes the results of AALC students for the 2020-21 Winter NWEA examinations.

Overall, students in grades K-8th did well on the 2020-21 Winter NWEA assessment. On average, most students showed growth in both Mathematics and Reading from their fall scores. There were a high number of students who even excelled and scored well above grade level. We enrolled several new students for this testing term, and most in grades 4th-7th scored above grade level in both subjects. Our teachers have already begun adjusting instruction to fit the needs of our students. With continued effort, AALC students will hopefully show growth on the Spring NWEA assessment as well.



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The following chart summarizes the growth of AALC students for the 2020-21 Fall to Spring NWEA examinations. This data does not reflect the students who enrolled at AALC after the Fall testing session.
