- ❖ **ADVOCATE FOR VIABLE, SOLUTION-BASED RESPONSES** for the end of mass incarceration; and
- ❖ **ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION AND SUPPORT** in and of the End Mass Incarceration Georgia Network.
