Main Duties/Responsibilities:

- Learn to plan fun and progressive development sessions using the Coach4U framework for senior coaches to assess and evaluate in order to improve and develop planning skills.
 - Full Coach4U coaching kit (including football boots for all outside football sessions), is to be worn to and from all sessions. Coaches are to wear a watch for time keeping (No phones are to be in sessions).
 - Arrive at sessions a minimum of 30 minutes before the start and 60 minutes before camps and ensure sessions are set up in advance of clients arriving.
 - Learn to ensure that the venue, equipment and all activities are health and safety checked, making the safety and wellbeing of young people paramount.
 - Welcome - parents and children by engaging and networking with them.
 - Shadow lead coach with the view of learning the structure, methods and techniques of coaching in all environments - with points of leading such as warm-ups and small groups required during the course of the year.
 - Progressively begin to lead sessions safely in accordance with the Coach4U session structure while being shadowed by senior staff.
 - Pack down equipment within 15 minutes of the session's end time.
 - To undertake any other duties as required by the line manager, where appropriate to the nature and grade of the post.
