- Personal Protective Equipment/Inventory

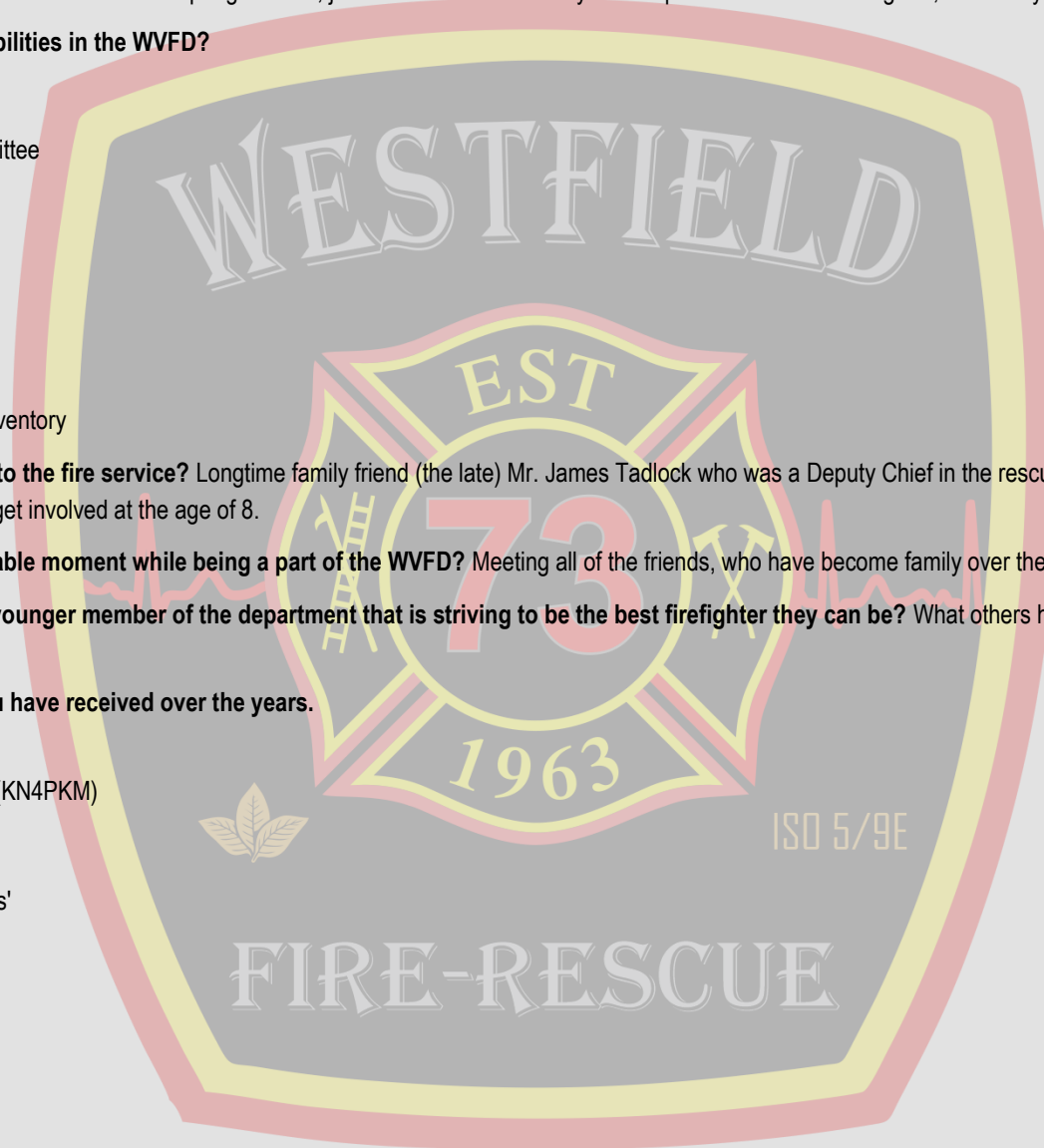
