



### Tribal Land Trust Nation Global ID & Liberty Pass

By Facts documented and issued to all Government Entities to Correct their Records

**Fact:** A Tribal identification card is also a valid form of government-issued photo identification in many places, though some places may be unaware of this.

**NOTICE:** our Tribal identification card is a Global ID inclusive of these 50 united states of the united states of America for all Travel on land, air, or sea.

**Fact:** Our Global ID Tribal Land Trust Nation is registered with Homeland Security, US Customs & Border Protection, and issued to the Office of Foreign Missions and the United Nations.

**Fact:** Our Liberty Pass is “ONLY” issued to Diplomats and Nationals (*living flesh, blood, and bone men/ [wo]men*) verified by our Embassy of California (*de jure*) Assembly.

**NOTICE:** IF someone creates or uses a fraudulent card or duplicates our information and it directly affects both our community, or a diplomat, or a national whose information was illegally used, and our tribal land trust nation was illegally used will be prosecuted. The use of fraudulent information typically translates directly to a loss of funds, which in turn can diminish the quality of services for eligible tribal diplomats or nationals. Where all are clearly warned all identification, plates, travel, etc. are secured by a PMA agreement by acquiesce. YOU HAVE BEEN PROPERLY INFORMED.

**Warning:** any third-party creations of our Global ID & Liberty Pass, not documented within our registry system will be held liable as a crime in their personal capacity damages of a \$50k retainer and \$5k an hour until resolved.

**Fact:** The Embassy of California (*de jure*) Assembly recognizes its community as Diplomats or Nationals within said Tribal Land Trust, created as of *29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2010* and secured as of the *28<sup>th</sup> day of February 2012*.

**Fact:** The Tribal Land Trust is documented within Riverside on said Land Patent CA CAAA 083204, Land Grant 486 (48,847.27 acres by Meridian) secured as of *29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2010*, coming forth as Calafia County, in dedication of Queen Calafia est. 1510.

**Fact:** On the Front of the Card, you will see: ‘Tribal Land Trust Nation Global ID & Liberty Pass’

**This** is a secured trust established on the *29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2010*, after 2+ years of Notice to the public with no rebuttal.

**Fact:** On the Back of the Card, you will see: ‘OFFICIAL Autochthonous’

**This** is a reference to our original status of Ancient people on the land through ancestors.

**Autochthonous Americans** are Indigenous to these lands, Ab Origine (from the beginning), and are therefore, entitled to security, protection, and preservation according to the following:

**Rights** (*verified by Honorable Yaffa bey*):

- Congress specifically acknowledges and reaffirms the trust responsibility and obligations of the united states Government to Indian Tribes, including Alaska Natives, for their preservation, protection, including the provision of health, education, social, and economic assistance programs as necessary...- “House Resolution 331,” (and the Senate concurs) October 4, 1988-
- United Nations “Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples.” September 13, 2007, specifically states:
  - Indigenous individuals have the rights to life, physical and mental integrity, liberty, and SECURITY of person- Article 7(1)-
  - Indigenous peoples have the collective right to live freedom, peace, and security as distinct peoples and “Shall NOT be subjected to any act of GENOCIDE or any other act of VIOLENCE, including forcibly removing children of the group to another group. -Article 7(2)-
  - Indigenous peoples and individuals have the right not to be subjected to forced assimilation or destruction of their culture. -Article 8(1)-

- State shall provide effective mechanisms for PREVENTION of, and redress for:
  - Any action which has the aim or effect of depriving them of their integrity as distinct peoples , or of their cultural values or ethnic identifies: -Article 8(2)a-
  - Any action which has the aim of dispossessing them of their lands, territories, or resources:- Article 8(2)b-
  - Any form of forced population transfer which has the aim or effect to violating or undermining any of their rights: Article 8(2)c-
  - Any form of forced assimilation or integration: -Article 8(2)d-
  - Any form of Propaganda designed to promote or incite racial or ethnic discrimination directed against them.- Article 8(2)e-
- Indigenous peoples and individuals' have the right to belong to an indigenous community or nation, in accordance with the tradition and customs of the community or nation concerned. No discrimination of any kind may arise from the exercise of such a right. – Article 9-
- United Nations “Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples,” September 13, 2007, specifically states: (continued)
  - Indigenous individuals have an equal right to the enjoyment of the highest attainable standard of physical and mental health. STATES shall take the necessary steps with a view to achieving progressively the full realization of this right. -Article 24(2)-
  - Indigenous peoples have the right to lands, territories, and resources which they have traditionally owned, occupied or otherwise used or acquired. -Article 26(1)-
  - Indigenous peoples have th right to own, use, develop, and control the lands, territories, and resources that they possess by reason of traditional ownership or other traditional occupation or use, as well as those which they have otherwise acquired.-Article 26(2)-
  - STATES shall give legal Recognition and Protection to these Lands, territories, and Resources. Such recognition shall be conducted with due respect to the customs, traditions, and land tenure systems of the indigenous peoples concerned. -Article 26(3)-
  - Indigenous peoples have the right to redress, by means that can include restitution, or, when this is not possible, just, fair, and equitable compensation, for the lands, territories, and resources which they have traditionally owned or otherwise occupied or used, and which have been confiscated, taken, occupied, used, or damaged without their free, prior, and informed consent. -Article 28(1)-
  - Unless otherwise freely agreed upon by the peoples concerned, compensation shall take the form of lands, territories, and resources equal in quality, size, and legal status, or of monetary compensation, or other appropriate redress. -Article 28(2)-
  - Indigenous peoples have the right to determine the responsibilities of individual to their communities. -Article 35-
- The “Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Genocide,” January 12, 1951, clearly states that complicity and/or conspiracy to commit genocide on an individual, or set of individuals, whose identity is defined by physical characteristics, or common country of nationality, in any plan to destroy the personal security, liberty, property, or lives of individuals belonging to such groups, via “Systematic Patterns” of coordinated acts is a punishable International Crime. -Article 2 and Article 3-

**Fact:** The Diplomat’s card will expire in 2099.

**This DOSE NOT INCLUDE OFFICIAL OFFICERS OF THE EMBASSY-** Officers are based on Contract Issued, Which may Very from 1-10 (one to ten) years.

**The OFFICIAL OFFICERS OF THE EMBASSY** Registered numbers are based on their Rank and Authority, which are only disclosed to the Government Entities.

**Fact:** The National’s card will expire in 5 (five) years from the date of issuance.

**Fact:** There are Member’s cards issued for Temporary visitation within the community, which timelines will also vary from 6 (six) months to 1 (one) year.
