TEEL ONE (b. 1974) is a graffiti-based artist who spent more than half of his youth painting on anything he could get his hands on, including toys from his parents' native lands of Cuba and Mexico. After losing his mother in 1989, he began to paint graffiti in Chicago, he found that the hip-hop subcultures provided an emotional refuge and surged his creative inspiration. TEEL ONE has been a big part of the Chicago graffiti scene since the 1990's. Later forming his own crew, store, and creating numerous platforms for others have helped him earn nationwide respect. His works have been exhibited nationwide since 2004 in Chicago, Elgin, Indiana, Wisconsin, San Francisco, Philadelphia, and New Jersey. His artworks have also been exhibited internationally at the 2008 400ML Exhibition at Maison De Metallos in Paris, France and at the 2022 3ra Jornado Binacional de Artistas Exhibition in Tijuana, Mexico.

TEEL ONE's graffiti practices have evolved into canvas paintings filled with sarcasm. His pop-art style exaggerates his interpretations of the American Dreamer. In his Sellout series, he cleverly interprets a hunger for success, while his Happy Food series comically depicts a hunger to be the chosen one. S.H.E. Gallery is honored to introduce TEEL ONE's paintings from his Sellout, Happy Foods, and oldie from his Gang series AND brand new, never seen artworks from his abstract art series!
