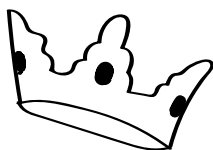

The Shiawassee Fair Queen and Attendant represent Shiawassee County and the Shiawassee County Fair at events throughout the area.

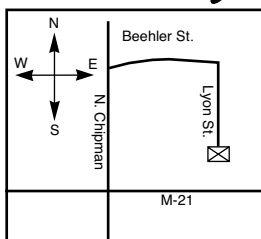
They will be selected at the 2022 Shiawassee County Fair Queen pageant on
