WELCOME TO THE SHIAWASSEE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

We are pleased to have you as our guest and hope that you have a pleasant stay. We take pride in the show facility that we offer your event and ask that you help us maintain the grounds for all that attend shows here.

CAMPING:

Camping begins at 2:00 pm on the day before your event starts. If you plug into the electrical box earlier than 2:00 pm that day there will be an extra ½ day charge. Those who arrive "days" earlier will be charged accordingly. Camping is to be in designated areas only; exhibitors may not "camp" in the barns.

A complimentary trip to the dump station at the end of your stay is included in the camping fee. If you arrive with full tanks, we will be glad to accommodate you – the fee is \$10.00 upon arrival.

BACK your camping unit into the camping space so that your camper could be pulled forward in an emergency; the tongue must face the road. [This is a requirement of the Dept. of Natural Resources, our licensing agency.] Park 12' away from the fence (to leave a fire lane) if you are camping on the west side of the grounds. Please note the location of the electrical boxes before backing into the space. If you should (unfortunately) hit one of the electrical boxes, please report it to the show office or grounds personnel immediately.

Water lines must be disconnected at all times except when you are actively filling your tanks. Watch for water lines as you drive tent stakes; many awning stakes are long enough to puncture the water lines. [The water lines run underground in a straight line from spigot to spigot.]

TRAILERS:

When you are showing out of your trailer, please park in the designated areas on the hard surface parking areas. This is the only area where animals may be tied to your trailers. Horses, cattle, or sheep may not be tied in the camping areas at any time.

BARNS:

Do not use nails or staples anywhere in the barns, for your animals safety. The hog panels (metal fence panels) in the stall doors and around the outside of all the barns are not designed to tie horses to or hang tack on.... please don't! As you choose stalls, please fill one barn before opening a new one.

SHAVINGS: We ask that shavings be paid for at or before the time of delivery. Show management will be responsible for shavings ordered and delivered to stalls prior to the start of a show.
