

BISHOP'S 2020 ANNUAL APPEAL: The 2020

Bishop's Annual Appeal has begun. This year the theme is Faith and Family. We are called to see Mary, Joseph and Jesus waiting at the door, to welcome us into the life of their home. Due to the pandemic Bishop Cary has made many changes to cut costs and adjust for this late start.

The overall Appeal participation goal is 20% and the supporting financial target is \$412,750. For our Parish, the participation goal is 220 families with a supporting target of \$34,265. St. Thomas has pledged 55.43% of its goal (\$18,992) and paid 33.71% (\$11,551.00) to date. If 700 families who have not yet pledged/donated make a one-time donation of \$10. we would easily meet our goal.

Many important diocesan and parish programs that help thousands in our diocese every year are made possible by your generosity such as tuition for seminarians, clergy formation, workshops for parish catechists, diocesan-wide youth retreats, as well as assistance to our Catholic Schools. Registered families should have received an Appeal packet from Bishop Cary with more information. Holy Cards, Prayer Intention Cards and Pledge envelopes are still available at all exits.

**OKTOBERFEST COVID STYLE:** Due to the cancellation of the November Saturday Night Live Oktoberfest dinner and speaker, we have the unique opportunity to sell the authentic German sausage and Sauerkraut we have served in the past. Informational flyers and order forms are currently available on the table at the church entrance and in the office. You can attach your check or cash and leave it with the office staff in the Church office.

Presales will also happen in the church entrance October 3 each weekend after Masses for three weeks. We must have a minimum in total sausage sales of 100 pounds to place the group order for our parish, and you will need to pay by cash or check only when you order. The cost per pound for the sausage is \$10.00 and the cost for the kraut per quart is \$5.00. Distribution for purchases will be November 7th and 8th.

MASKS/FACE SHIELDS: COVID viral spread is affected by: (1) distance from someone not wearing a face covering. (2) Sneezing and coughing which increases the number of virus particles near you. (3) Singing or speaking forcefully which releases more virus than speaking quietly. Mass attendees at St. Thomas should be socially distanced (6 feet in all directions) and properly wearing face masks or face shields in the manner recommended by the CDC. If you need a mask, please see Donna Jensen in the office during office hours.

BABY BOTTLE UPDATE: As of 9/14/2020, you have generously donated nearly \$3,300 to the 2020 campaign for our Respect for Life Appeal. We set out 189 bottles; all but 30 were taken to fill; and at last count, 131 bottles have been returned, leaving 28 still unaccounted for. When you can, please return unused bottles, or those you have filled, to the church office, so we don't have to purchase more for next year's appeal. Your Respect of Life Committee greatly thanks all of you for your prayers, help, and participation.
