

OKTOBERFEST COVID STYLE: Due to the cancellation of the November Saturday Night Live Oktoberfest dinner and speaker, we have the unique opportunity to sell the authentic German sausage and Sauerkraut we have served in the past. Informational flyers and order forms are currently available on the table at the church entrance and in the office. You can attach your check or cash and leave it with the office staff in the Church office.

Presales will also happen in the church entrance October 3 each weekend after Masses for three weeks. Orders are due by October 19. We must have a minimum in total sausage sales of 100 pounds to place the group order for our parish, and you will need to pay by cash or check only when you order. The cost per pound for the sausage is \$10.00 and the cost for the kraut per quart is \$5.00. Distribution for purchases will be November 7th and 8th.




