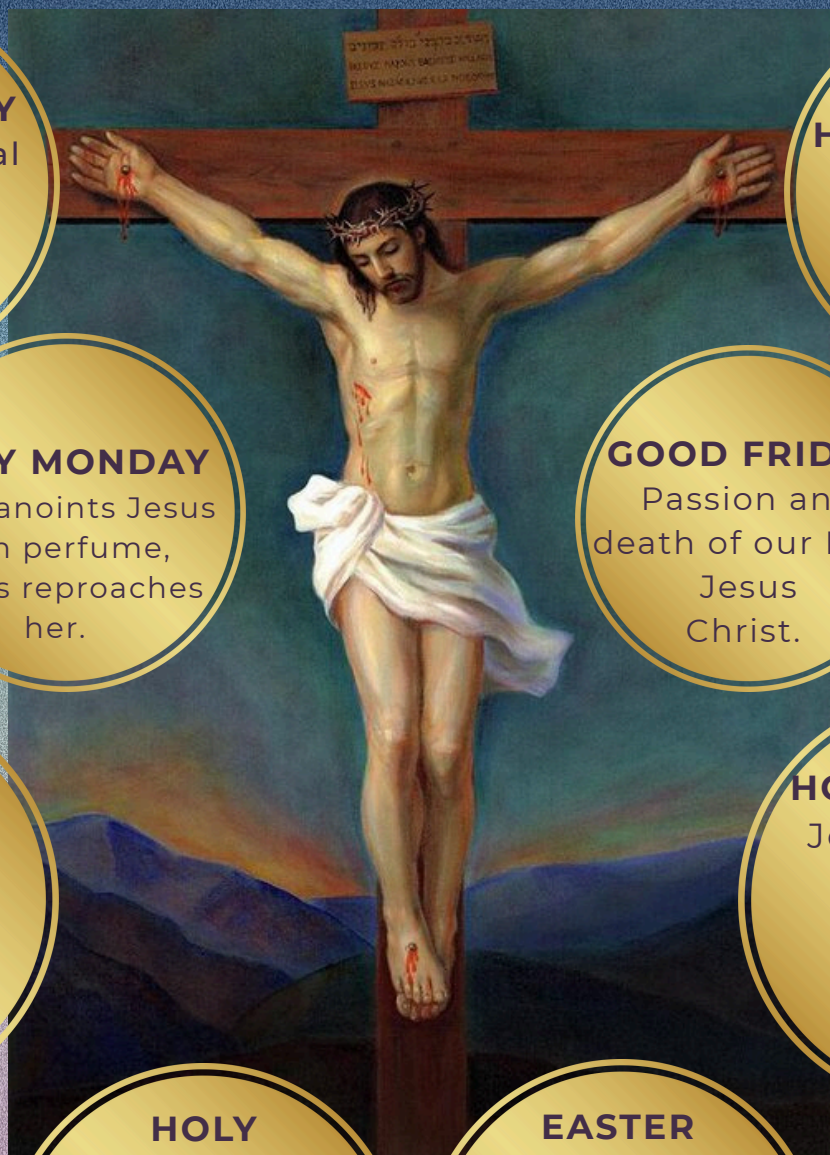

This Sunday is Passion or, Palm Sunday. During the weeks of Lent, we have prepared for this final week by fasting, praying and almsgiving, all with the purpose of opening ourselves more fully

to God's presence in our lives. The Journey begins with Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem and begins Holy Week. As the Lord came from outside the city of Jerusalem, so we gather outside of the church, where we hear the Gospel proclaimed and palms are blessed and distributed. Then we, like the crowds of those centuries ago, sing Psalms as we enter the church, in praise of Jesus, the King and Messiah. The Mass itself focuses on the Paschal Mystery, with special attention to Jesus' suffering, as foretold and described in passages on the "Suffering Servant" from Isaiah, Psalm 21, the hymn to Jesus in Philippians 2, and a reading of the Passion from the Gospel of that liturgical year. We can't help but notice the crowd of which we are a part. It is fitting that this liturgy ends soberly, as we reflect on the events of the week to come and our role in it.
