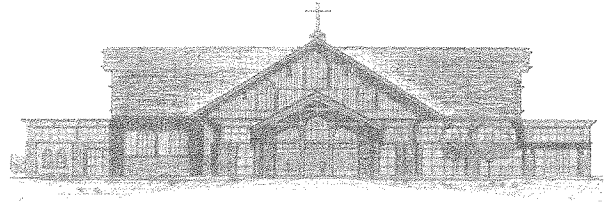

**BISHOP'S 2020 ANNUAL APPEAL:**

The 2020 Bishop's Annual Appeal begins this week. This year the theme is Faith and Family. We are called to see Mary, Joseph and Jesus waiting at the door, to welcome us into the life of their home. Due to the pandemic Bishop Cary has made many changes to cut costs and adjust for this late start.

The overall Appeal participation goal is 20% and the supporting financial target is \$412,750. For our Parish, the participation goal is 220 families with a supporting target of \$34,265.

Many important diocesan and parish programs that help thousands in our diocese every year are made possible by your generosity such as tuition for seminarians, clergy formation, workshops for parish catechists, diocesan-wide youth retreats, as well as assistance to our Catholic Schools. Registered families should have received an Appeal packet from Bishop Cary with more information. Holy Cards, Prayer Intention Cards and Pledge envelopes are still available at all exits.

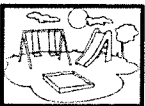

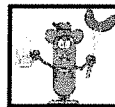

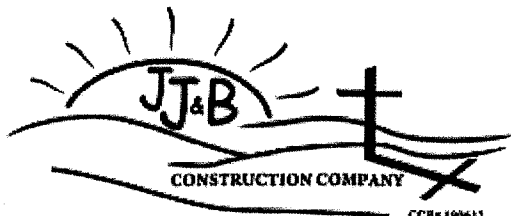

St. Thomas Adult Bible Study

What's happening this coming year?

Unfortunately, we won't be able to continue with the past bible study format because of Covid-19. But the GOOD news is that we have two GREAT new options to keep you fed on your spiritual journey!

Option #1 - Join the new book club! Leah Bickett has chosen a variety of solidly Catholic non-fiction and fiction books that look great and will appeal to all readers. After the group has finished reading the book, people can choose whether or not they would like to discuss the book with a group. More on how that will happen after we tell you about Option 2. Every 6 weeks a new book will be introduced. You can choose to participate or wait for the next cycle.

Option #2 - Be part of a *small* Bible Study group. You can choose to form your own group, or sign-up and be placed in a group. What resources are available for groups? Your group can:

- a) Borrow one of the bible studies which the Church already owns from the Parish Library. Typically this includes a DVD and at least one *sample* Study Guide. Please do not write in the Study Guide. Additional Study Guides can be purchased by each participant through the company producing the study or by calling them.
- b) Purchase a new study from Catholic websites Ascension Press, Word on Fire, etc. Starter Sets (One DVD and one Study Guide) can be purchased with Church funds with prior approval. Additional Study Guides can be purchased by each participant.
- c) Go online to Formed.org which the Church has subscription to and use one of the free bible studies. Videos can be streamed or the DVD can be purchased. Study Guides can be purchased or some can be printed out.

d) Purchase a study that uses just a book and not a DVD (such as Fr Mitch Pacwa's studies.) Again participants will purchase their own book either online or by asking a local book store to order it for them.

The small groups should be anywhere from 4 to 12 persons depending on the space or situation:

- Zoom groups - 10 to 12 persons
- Small groups in homes - 4-8 persons
- Small groups in the Fireside room at Church – 4-8 persons

Charlotte Curtis will put the groups together for both the Book Club and the Bible Study using *your* preferences. To participate, just notify Charlotte at: caalec@outlook.com or call her at 541-279-9978. She will then email you a questionnaire about your preferences before she puts the groups together. (you can do both Option 1 & 2 if you want!) Examples of the questions you will be asked are things like: who do you want to be in a group with, do you want to Zoom or meet in person, can you host a group in your home, when would you like to meet, etc.

The Book Club and Bible Study groups will begin sometime in *October*. The sooner we know that you would like to participate, the sooner we can get it organized so don't delay in your response to Charlotte! As soon as she gets the groups formed, you will get an email or phone call (however you prefer to be contacted) giving you the necessary information.

Watch for additional updates in the Church Bulletin and the Church's online message system.
