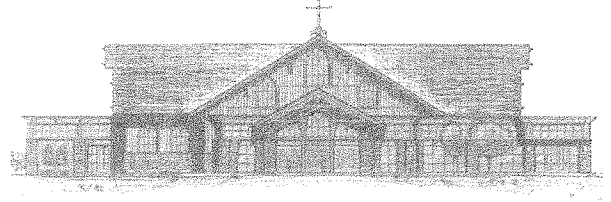

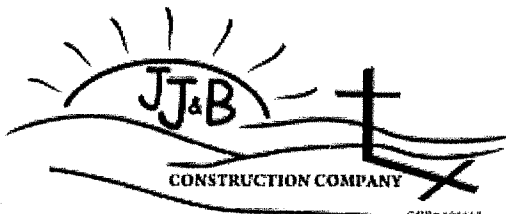

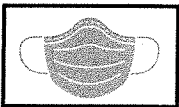

MASKS/FACE SHIELDS: COVID viral spread is affected by: (1) distance from someone not wearing a face covering. (2) Sneezing and coughing which increases the number of virus particles near you. (3) Singing or speaking forcefully which releases more virus than speaking quietly. **Mass attendees at St. Thomas can respect others by socially distancing (6 feet in all directions) and properly wearing face masks or face shields in the manner recommended by the CDC; that is, covering the nose and mouth.**



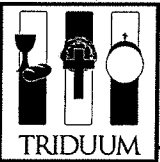
LENTEN OBLIGATIONS: All Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Good Friday (April 2nd). The U.S. bishops define fasting as eating one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted as necessary to maintain strength.

Please note that First Friday and First Saturday observances will not take place in April due to Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

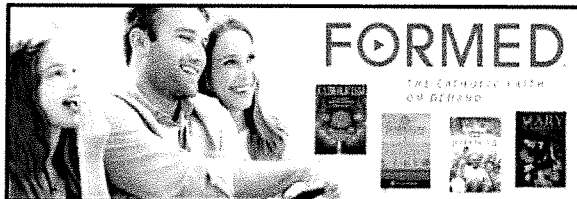
