ABOUT OUR PROGRAMS



CHRISTIAN DOCTRINES

It is the study of fundamental teachings of the Bible in a systematic way. This study is about the Bible, God, Christ, Holy Spirit, People, Salvation, Church and Eschatology.

ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

It is the study of the founding the Christian church and the spread of its message to the Roman Empire. The focus will be on the Holy Spirit's involvement in the church and its mission.

HOLY SPIRIT

A study of the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit, with the emphasis on Pentecostal experience and Spiritual Gifts. The activity of the Holy spirit in the Old Testament, New Testament, His ministry in and through believers. He seals, baptizes, fills, anoints and inspires the followers of Christ.

THE CHURCH

This course explores the nature, origin and purpose of the New Testament Church with the explanation of its ministerial officers and the forms of church government. Attention is also given to the ordinances of the Church and how different traditions view and practice them.

JOURNEY THROUGH THE NEW TESTAMENT

An introduction to the books of the New Testament, with special emphasis on the life, teachings, and redemptive work of Christ; the founding and growth of the church; and the teachings of the epistles and Revelation. On the basis of the biblical text, parallel readings and lectures, the events and messages of the New Testament will be portrayed against their historical and cultural setting.

HOMILETICS

It is the study of the composition and practice of the preaching of the Word of God. The scope of the subject includes such things as the source and presentation of the sermon, the preacher, and the audience.

JOURNEY THROUGH THE OLD TESTAMENT

Survey the entire Old Testament, with a focus on understanding the major contents of each book. Examines literary structure, historical backgrounds, geographical settings, and parallel passages to enhance comprehension and application to contemporary issues and concerns.

NEW TESTAMENT LIFE & SERVICE

This is a brief study of the inseparable and equally important relationship between the life and ministry of a contemporary Christian leader for a Christ-centered service. The course examines the preparation, character, pitfalls, spiritual authority, power for the ministry and other relevant matters that assists a spiritual leader in his advancement and productivity.

EVANGELISM & CHURCH GROWTH

The Christian Church is called to announce the gospel of Jesus Christ and make disciples of all nations. This study focuses on the evangelistic efforts of the community of believers and the growing of healthy reproducing churches. Emphasis is given to the pattern and principles of the Apostolic Church found in Acts of the Apostles.

PASTORAL THEOLOGY (ONLY FOR PASTOR'S)

The practical aspect of the Christian Ministry is the focus of this course with the emphasis of equipping the pastors who are serving as local church leaders. Guidelines for conducting various services and doing them with grace, dignity and competency is discussed. Participants of this course may be asked to demonstrate their unique style of conducting services: Dedication of a child, Water Baptism, Home Visits, Follow up calls, Weddings, Funerals and others.

WOMEN IN MINISTRY (ONLY FOR WOMEN)

This course is designed to equip and train the Christian women who have a calling to serve God with their God-given gifts in their local churches or in other areas with the partnership and supervision of local or national leadership of the Church. This is for women only and is an alternative for Pastoral theology.

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

This course takes a practical and biblical look at leadership principles and how to care for others.

BIBLE STUDY METHODS AND RULES OF INTERPRETATION

An introduction to basic Bible study methods and rules of interpretation with emphasis on accurately understanding and obeying God's Word and the development of practical skills. To determine what Scripture says, what it means, and how it can be applied. To train pastors and church leaders to properly and systematically study and interpret the Bible in order to "correctly handle the Word of Truth" so that they may be "equipped for every good work." To help pastors and church leaders as they preach and teach others.

The LSM is seeking to introduce advanced level courses and accreditation of the institution with other recognised bodies & institutions.

Offering selected practical study courses to improve the ministry skills and build confidence in the minister.
