Individually, his best postseason was in the 2012-2013 postseason. Krejci had 9 goals, 17 assists which equals out to 26 points, and his plus minus was 13. He is 2nd with the franchise during the postseason on assists. David is tied for 2nd in postseason points. Along with that, Kreici has played the 3rd most postseason games in Bruins history.
