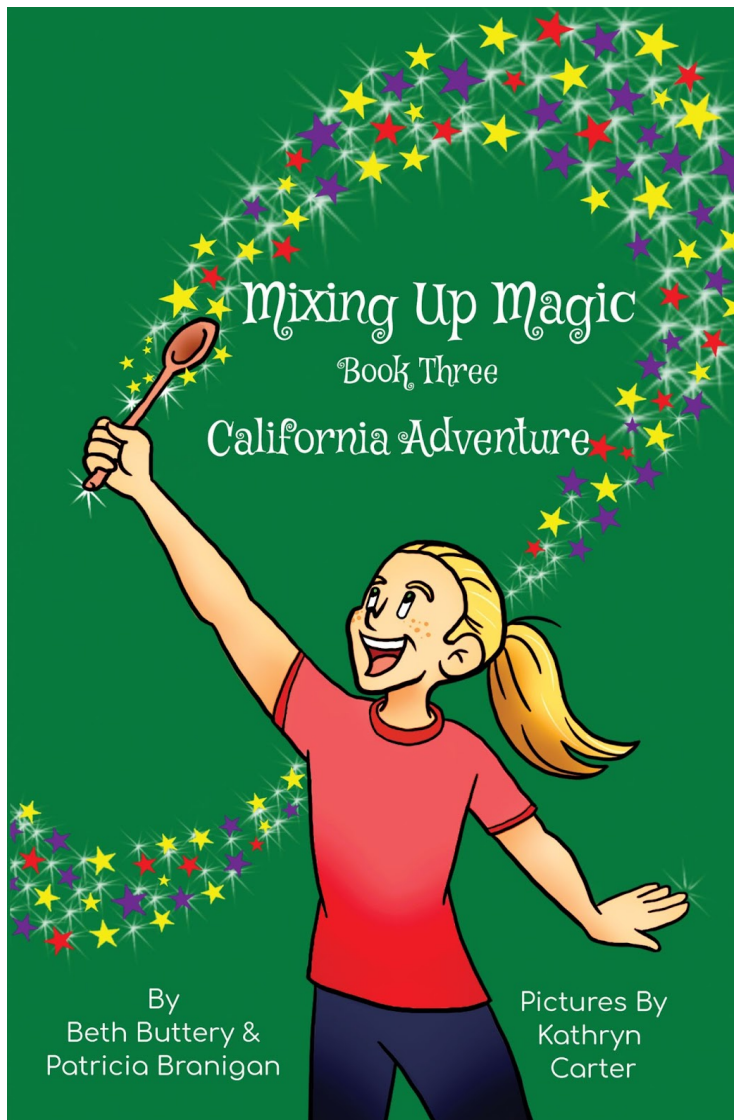

Find out in the third Mixing Up Magic book, Mixing Up Magic: California Adventure!

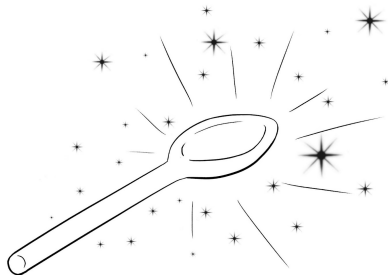
