# Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a resident of North Florida.
- You must live and attend school in the selected North Florida counties.
- Must be a natural born female.
- Must never have been married or had a marriage annulled.
- Must never have given birth to a child, cannot be a parent or guardian of any other adult or minor person, and cannot currently be pregnant.
- Must comply with all eligibility requirements outlined in the official contestant entry form.

#### Rehearsal:

A MANDATORY rehearsal is scheduled for Friday, February 14th at 4:00PM for all Tiny-Little Miss contestants; and Saturday February 15th at 9:00 AM for all Junior-Miss Contestants

All 8X10 photogenic entries should be turned in at this time.

#### **Opening Number:**

For opening number all contestants must wear the Marc Defang opening number dress. Order form link will be posted in the group page. Dress order MUST be placed no later than December 1, 2024

This portion will not be judged!

#### **Introduction:**

Each Contestant will be introduced by the emcee. Each contestant will step forward, pose, wave and exit the stage.

#### Parade of Gowns:

Each contestant will participate in a parade of gowns showing off their gowns and beauty before the competition begins.

This portion will not be judged.

## Required Competitions

#### **Evening Gown**

Wear a floor length gown of your choice. There is no preferred type of evening gown, as we desire to let each delegate showcase their own sense of fashion. Keep in mind that each delegate should look her age. Each delegate will have their moment in the spot light, to show their grace, poise and elegance!




## Fun Fashion

This is your opportunity to rock the runway! Compete in a red carpet style outfit of your choice. This fun and upbeat competition gives delegates the freedom to showcase their modeling skills while showing their personality and unique sense of style and fashion.



## Interview

Wear an interview outfit that reflects your unique personality. Questions will come from your bio sheet. Contestants interview panel style in front of all judges for 3 minutes and should prepare a brief ice breaker introduction as they enter the interview room.



# On Stage Question

Only the Top 6 will participate in an on-stage question for the final phase of competition. This will be a small percentage of the overall score. This phase provides the judges with another opportunity to hear from the final delegates, and provides the audience with a glimpse into the delegate's interview.

## Optionals/Side Awards

Community Service/Role Model

This competition is based on your community service and mentoring activities as depicted in a scrapbook. There will two (2) overall winners for this category. One (1) Junior. Division Winner and one (1) Senior Division winner.



Two Contestants will be awarded the Community Service Award and will each receive a \$250.00 Cash Scholarship!

## Scholar Award

This competition is for the Teen and Miss Division only, and is based on your academic achievements. All entries must include a sealed transcript, and the contestant must provide a brief essay which will be read by pageant judges, prior to the pageant. This should be a personal essay giving the judges a better look at your academic success, your academic goals and how they compliment your community service goals.



One Contestant will be awarded the Academic Achievement Award and will receive a \$250.00 Cash Scholarship!

## Additional Awards

### **Zoe Romine Congeniality Award**

This award is given to the little miss contestant who is known by her peers as the most friendly, helpful, genuine, and outgoing. The congeniality winner is considered a highly coveted award as it is given by the "judges" who are constantly interacting with our Little Miss delegates: the other delegates, her peers. The winner of the 2025 award will receive an award and a \$200 Cash Scholarship.



## **Emma Weeks Platform Award**

This award is named after and awarded by Emma Weeks, the first Junior Miss North Florida.

Emma found her passion and built a platform that continues to positively impact her community to this day. This award is given to celebrate a young woman competing tonight that shows the same dedication to her own passion as she positively impacts her community. The winner of the 2025 award will receive an award and a \$200 Cash Scholarship.



#### **Kadance Fredericksen Heart of Service Award**

This award recognizes the valuable contributions made through community service. The award is named after Kadance Fredericksen, our 2021 Teen Miss North Florida, and her efforts through her own organization, Kada's Promise. Kadance has a heart and passion to help raise awareness and help abused children. To date, Kadance has directly impacted and comforted the lives of over 12,000 mistreated children internationally. The winner of the 2025 award will receive an award and a \$200 Cash Scholarship.

### Cassie Brown Scholar Award



The Cassie Brown Academic Achievement Award was established to honor and recognize a contestant in the Miss division for outstanding achievement in academics, grades, honors, awards, and school involvement.
