When the Health Care System becomes an Oligopoly/Monopoly, it becomes a market system that is less than a perfect market competition.

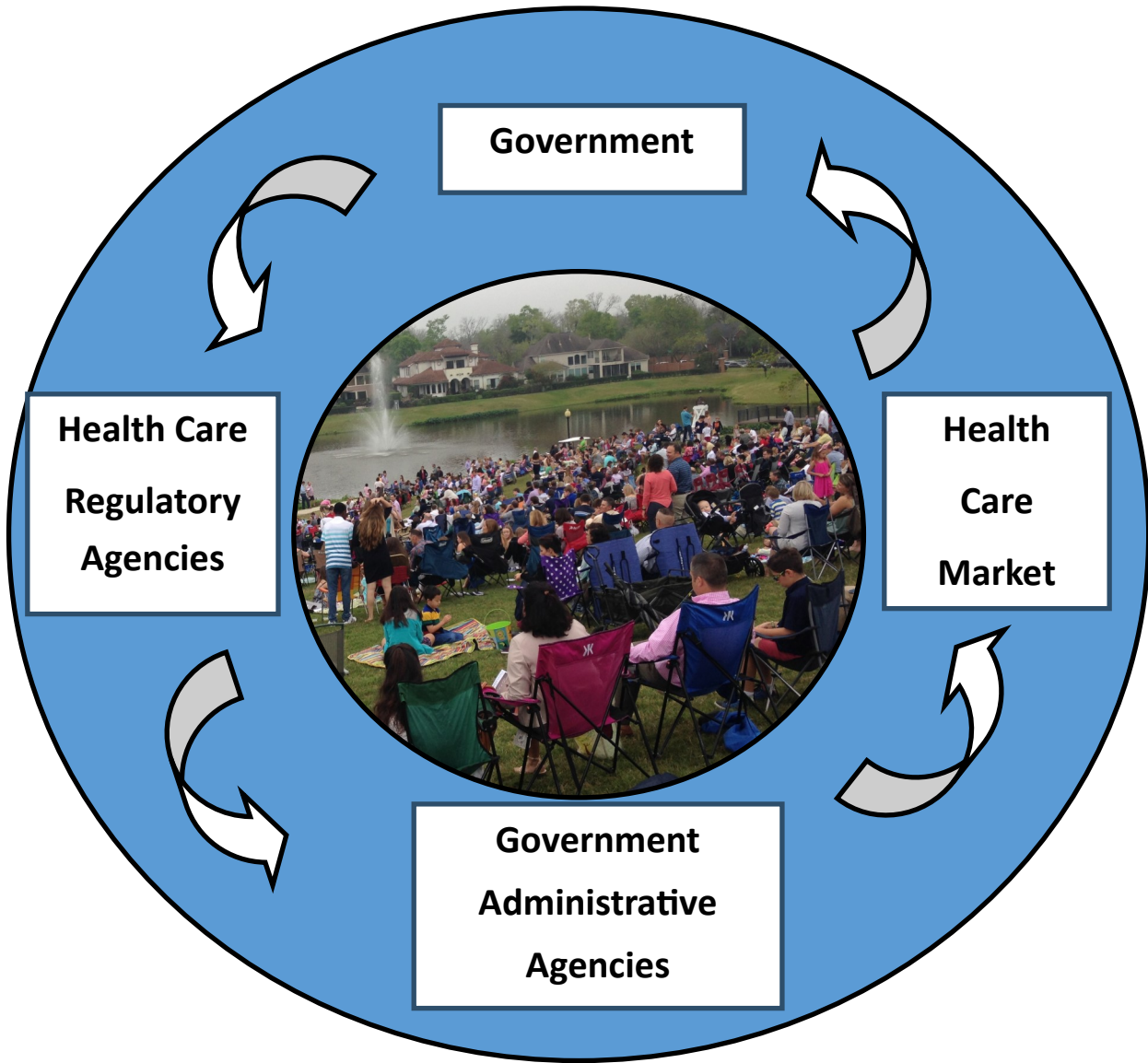
It is the duty of the government to take over the health care system and its market and give power back to the Communities, creating a market system

It is the duty of the government and the Affordable Health Care Act to create avenues for the development of **Community Based Self-Sustained Health Care Systems** by mobilizing the Com-

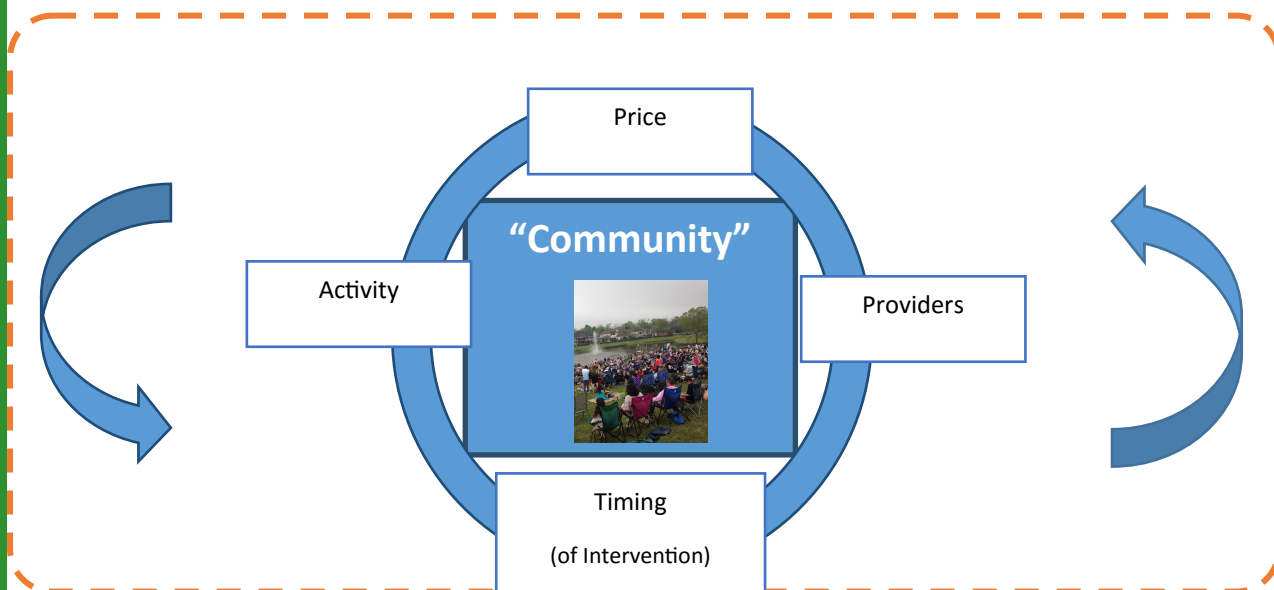
**The Community Owned and Sustained

Activities, Price, Timing of Intervention and its Providers.

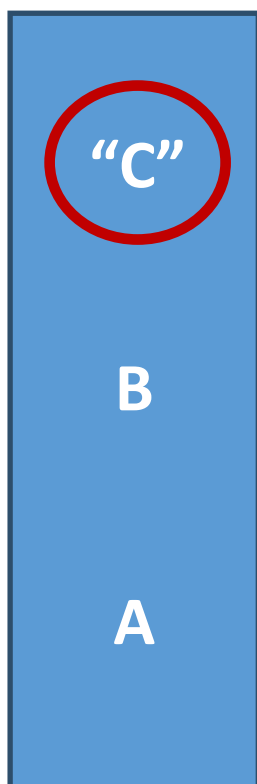


munities in US to create self-sustaining systems to execute effective and efficient strategies for the **Optimal Wellbeing** of their stakeholders, the Communities and the families it represents.

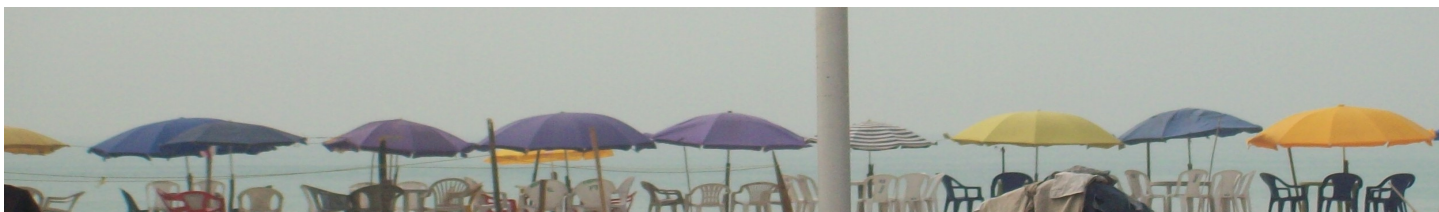
Open the Health Care Market so that each Community member can choose to invest in its health care structure, in exchange of equity, for the future of the Community members and their families.
