ACADEMICS

Pre K - Kindergarten

Prior to the first session, the student will be pre-assessed to determine where he/she needs to begin. We will focus on alphabet recognition, alphabet sounds, short vowels and consonants, long vowels, consonant blends, sight words, recognizing numbers, counting to 20 up to 100, basic addition facts, and etc.

Grades One - Three

Students in grades 1-3 will be tutored in areas based on teacher recommendation or for general extra practice. The students will be required to have a book on hand at every session.
