

Ask A Bronco Terms of Use

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1. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing or using the Site, you agree to be bound by these terms. If you do not agree to these terms, you may not access or use the Site.

2. Eligibility

You must be a student, faculty, staff, alumnus, or prospective student of the University, and at least 16 years of age, to use this Site. By using the Site, you represent and warrant that you meet this eligibility requirement. You also agree to provide accurate information about yourself as prompted by the Site’s questionnaire. If you provide any information that is inaccurate, or if the Site administrators have reasonable grounds to believe that such information is inaccurate, then your use of the Site may be suspended or terminated.

3. User Conduct

You agree to use the Site in a professional manner, consistent with the purposes for which the Site is intended. By way of example, and not as a limitation, you may not use the services of the Site to:

- b. Violate any applicable laws or regulations.
- c. Create a false identity for the purpose of impersonating or misleading others.

- e. Harvest or otherwise collect information about others, including email addresses.
- f. Defame, abuse, harass, stalk, threaten or otherwise violate the legal rights (such as rights of privacy and publicity) of others.
- g. Publish, distribute, or otherwise disseminate any inappropriate, profane, defamatory, obscene, indecent, unlawful or confidential material or information.

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- h. Use the Site for political activities or commercial purposes.
- i. Advertise or offer to sell or buy any goods or services, or solicit an investment in any business.
- j. Send junk mail, spam, chain letters or any duplicative or unsolicited messages (commercial or otherwise).
- k. Solicit others to participate in surveys, contests, pyramid schemes, or other similar activities.
- l. Interfere with or disrupt the Site or servers or networks connected to the Site, or otherwise attempt to compromise the security of the Site.

The University reserves the right to monitor and screen information and communications transmitted through the Site. You remain solely responsible for all the information you submit to the Site and all communications and other interactions you have with others that you connect with as a result of the Site. If it comes to the University's attention, the University may take action against any user that violates these Terms, including without limitation asking Protopia to suspend or terminate the user's access to or use of the Site.
