



2nd Tax Installment Due March 31

If you chose to pay your property taxes using the installment plan, the 2nd installment is due on Sunday, March 31.

Property tax payments can be paid via US mail, online, or in Village Hall during regular business hours.

The drop box at Village Hall will be locked on March 12 through April 2 due to the Spring Election absentee voting rules.

The 3rd tax installment is due May 31, 2024.

Election Day: April 2

The Presidential Preference Primary and Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 2. The polls will be open from 7am to 8pm. Bayside residents have one (1) polling location - 9075 N Regent Rd, Bayside, WI: Village Hall Board Room. All voters will enter through the front door of Village Hall.

All voters must have a photo ID when voting. Acceptable forms of photo ID can be found <u>here</u>.

If you are registering to vote on Election Day, you must provide photo ID and <u>Proof</u> of <u>Residence</u>.

If you are returning your absentee ballot on Election Day, please bring it to the Clerk's Office (front counter), not to the polling

room.

Pet Licenses due March 31

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

The final days for in-person absentee voting are:

In-person absentee voting is not available the Monday before Election Day.

Yard Waste Collection

The first full yard waste collection of the year will be conducted the week of April 1.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, April 1st to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested <u>here</u>.

In the summer of 2023, the East Bayside Sanitary Sewer Relief Project was completed, consisting of the development of a new sanitary sewer relief system for the area bounded by East Bay Point Road to the north, North Bayside Drive to the



east, East Hermitage Road to the south, and North Lake Drive to the west.

The final repaying of the roads, North Lake Drive from East Manor Circle to East Fairy Chasm, and East Fairy Chasm Road from North Lake Drive to North Tennyson Drive, will be completed by the end of May.
