CLEAN UP DAY

Completing your spring cleaning and need a place to dispose of unwanted items? The Spring Clean Up Day will be held on Saturday, April 13 from 9am to 12pm for Village of Bayside residents. The event will take place at the Public Works building with the entrance off Regent Road. A monetary donation or a three non-perishable food item donation for the Hunger Task Force is required for participation.

Accepted items: garbage, recycling, yard waste, scrap metal, electronics (TV and monitor fees must be paid in advance), bikes, clothing and textiles, light bulbs, paint, plastic bags, cell phones, ink cartridges, humidifiers, paper for shredding, motor oil, paint, and eyeglasses. YARD WASTE

April marks the beginning of yard waste pick-up throughout the Village. DPW crews will be collecting yard waste the weeks of April 1, April 15, and April 29.

- Crews pass by each home once.
- Branches must be parallel to the road and less than 5' long.
- Do not put yard waste in plastic bags, garbage carts, or recycling carts.
- Combine all materials into one pile per property.

ADOPT-A-TREE

The Village of Bayside is again offering the Adopt-A-Tree program.

Public right-of-way trees: The cost/tree is \$250, which includes the tree, planting, mulching, and initial watering. Trees will be planted in the right-of-way.

Private property trees: The cost/tree is \$300, which includes the tree only. Trees can be planted on private property.

There are three different tree options to choose from, including Autumn Gold Ginkgo, Green Gable Black Gum, and Snowdance Lilac.

Trees are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
