The deadline to order your Adopt-A-Tree is **Wednesday, May 1**.

Choose between three tree options as we continue our efforts to maintain a 5% species threshold and to diversify the Village's tree population!

2024 Tree Options:

- Autumn Gold Gingko
- Green Gable Black Gum
- Snowdance Tree Lilac

Location Options:

- Public Right-of-Way Trees: Cost per tree is \$250 and includes 1 tree, planting in the public right-of-way, mulching and initial watering.
- Private Property Trees: Cost per tree is \$300 and only includes the tree. Trees can be planted on private property.

Drug Take Back Day

Drug Take Back Day will be held on **Saturday, April 27, 2024** in the Bayside Police Department Lobby from 10am to 2pm.

Bringing unused and unwanted medications to a Drug Take Back Day collection site protects you, your family, and your community.

In October of 2023, Wisconsin ranked number one throughout the country for the





most prescription medications collected during the Fall 2023 Drug Take Back. Wisconsin collected 53,122 lbs. of unwanted medications last fall.

Acceptable Items:

- Prescription and over-the-counter medications
- Ointments
- Sprays
- Inhalers
- Creams
- Vials
- Pet medication

Unacceptable Items:

- Needles/sharps
- Items containing bodily fluid or blood
- Personal care products
- · Household hazardous waste

Yard Waste Collection

The next full yard waste collection of the year will be conducted the week of April 29.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, April 29 to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested <u>here</u>.

The Village hosted a successful Clean Up Day on Saturday, April 13. During the 3 hour event, the Village collected:

- 3 dumpsters full of garbage
- 1.71 tons of recycling
- Half full metal dumpster
- 3/4 full Habitat for Humanity truck
- Full Goodwill semi-trailer
- 27 pairs of eyeglasses
- 200 pounds of automotive batteries
- 131 ink cartridges
- 12 cell phones
- 30 gallons of loose light bulbs
- 202 fluorescent light bulb tubes
- 825 gallons of plastic bags
- 300+ pounds of paper for shredding
- 20 yards of yard waste
- 7 bins of electronics for recycling
- 240 gallons of paint
- 17 bikes for Dream Bikes
- Roughly 2,305 pounds of Household Hazardous Waste
