TAX BILLS COMING IN DECEMBER

Bayside residents will be receiving their 2023 tax bills in the mail by mid-December. Full payment or the first installment is due by January 31, 2024. The 2023 installment plan has the following 2024 deadlines: January 31, March 31, May 31.

Payments for the tax bill can be made in the following ways:

By Mail: Village of Bayside, 9075 N. Regent Road, Bayside, WI 53217. If you would like a receipt, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope or an email address.

In-person at Bayside Village Hall: During regular business hours or drop in the night deposit box located near the American flag, in the circular drive at Village Hall. Bayside Village Hall is closed December 22 and 25 as well as December 29 and January 1, during which time tax bills may be deposited in the night deposit box.

Online: Visit <https://pp-milwaukee-co-wi-fb.app.landnav.com/Login> and sign in as a guest. Search your address and select the 2023 tax bill. Click the 'Taxes' tab at the top of the page and add your desired payment amount to your cart. View your cart and click 'Checkout'!

HOLIDAY DROP-OFF DAY

The annual Holiday Recycling Day will be held on Wednesday, December 27 from 2-5pm in the DPW parking lot. Items accepted include yard waste, bagged leaves, excess cardboard and recycling, scrap metal, and acceptable electronics. Please enter off Fairy Chasm Road.

LAST COLLECTIONS

The last loose leaf collection and yard waste collection of the season will begin on November 27 and end on December 1. **Please keep piles separate.** Remember to have your piles roadside by 7am on Monday, November 27 as DPW crews only pass each house once. Please do not place any branches or yard waste with leaves.

When the holidays start to wind down, DPW will be collecting holiday trees roadside. Holiday tree pick-up will take place on January 4 and 11. Please have trees roadside by 7am of the collection day you plan to participate in.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT MT. BAYSIDE!

Dust off your sleds! Mt. Bayside is open! The hill offers fun for all ages so make sure you head over when the snow flies! The sled hill is located next to Village Hall on Regent Road. You will need to park in the sled hill parking lot located off Fairy Chasm Road. Please do not park in the north Village Hall lot, as this is for employee use only.

BEWARE OF PORCH PIRATES!

With the large volume of packages left on porches this holiday season, minimize the risk of having yours stolen. If you know you won't be home when your package arrives, have it rerouted to a secure facility to require a signature upon delivery. Smart doorbells can work with your cell phone so you can see who's at your front door. If you see someone suspicious in your neighborhood, dial 911, or call Bayside Police for non-emergency issues at 414-206-3916. Keep your packages safe this holiday season!

PROTECTION AND PREVENTION

Ensure your water pipes are ready for winter as colder temperatures can wreak havoc on unprepared water pipes. To keep your water flowing, follow these tips:

- Disconnect and drain hoses from outside faucets
- Turn off and drain irrigation systems and backflow assemblies
- Insulate pipes in unheated spaces, such as garages, crawl spaces, and attics
- Show household members how to turn off water to the house in case of an emergency
